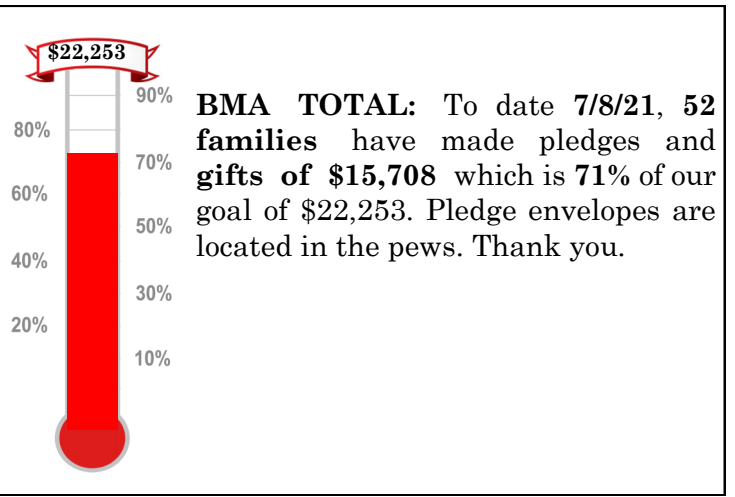

PASTOR'S MESSAGE

As we continue to re-focus our returning to the Holy Days of Obligation at the Mass, the Church, our Diocese and our Parish wants us to remember why we come to worship, to give thanks, to praise,

adore and glorify the Lord. This is out of pure love to the one who created us out of His love. We simply give Him our due for the life he has given us. Putting our trust, our faith, and our willingness to submit to him in obedience His will, so that we may come to know the 'first fruits' of peace and joy in this world as a foretaste to it's fullness that awaits us in heaven.

This requires our response to the Lord's call to holiness, as the sheep hears the shepherd and follows. How we do this, because of our fallen nature, it's not all that easy, it's an effort that takes work. The 'work' of the people of God to hear and follow is called the Liturgy. Sometimes it takes real effort even to pray. The word *liturgy*, derived from the technical term in ancient Greek, *leitourgia*, which literally means "work for the people" is a literal translation of the two words "litos ergos" or "public service".

There is a Latin maxim that addresses the centrality of worship in the life, identity and mission of the Catholic Church; "Lex Orandi, Lex Credendi". The phrase in Latin literally means the law of prayer ("the way we worship") is the law of belief ("what we believe"). How we worship reflects what we believe and determines how we will live.

Fr. Larry Machado, pastoral vicar at the Cathedral of the Annunciation in the Stockton Diocese has recorded a mini series, a seminar on the Liturgy of the Church. Fr. Larry, a new priest, teaches the origins of the catholic liturgy from the Old Testament book of Exodus, God's paternal care for Israel, to the New Covenant of Jesus' "Do this in memory of me." Please check it out; it is very informative, comprehensive and easy to follow.

Let us all remember why we come to church. We come for the First Commandment: to love the Lord our God, with all our hearts, with all our souls, and with all our minds; this is why we worship, and give Him praise and Thanksgiving. Let us renew our commitment to This Love, as we celebrate the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass, all for the Glory of God.
