The Gardener and the Soil

I began writing this piece by googling "how do you make soil fertile?" which should tell you everything you need to know about my own abilities as a gardener.

I remember seeing a packet of seeds in the store one summer as a child & convincing my mother to buy them. They were delphiniums, which bloom into a beautiful cone shape if you know what you're doing. Alas, I didn't. I chose a particularly dry spot of earth next to my back-yard playset, scattered the seeds, congratulated myself, & went on my merry way. I returned occasionally to water the area, but only when I remembered to.

Nothing grew, not even a little sprout. I was heartbroken — my faith was shaken. I had planted these seeds! I had watered them! (A little.) There was sunlight! All my childhood books & rhymes said this was all you needed. Was it all a lie? Of course it wasn't a lie. Seeds need soil, sunlight, water, & oxygen — good soil, adequate sunlight for whatever the plant is, & consistent water.

So what seeds need more than anything is a gardener.

When I hear the parable of the rich soil & the rocky ground in the Gospel of Matthew, I often miss the point. I think Jesus is trying to give me a message about how I should be. "Be better." That's what I think he's telling me. I forget that I am only the soil. I cannot enrich myself; all my efforts to do so will come to nothing. What he is telling me is to ask the gardener: "Make me what I need to be."

St. Henry | July 13

St. Henry is the only Holy Roman Emperor to be canonized as a saint. He is the patron saint of the childless & the handicapped.

St. Henry was born in 972. In 995, St. Henry succeeded his father as Duke of Bavaria, & in 1002, upon the death of his cousin, Otho III, he was elected emperor. In 1014, St. Henry undertook the long journey from Germany to Rome to be crowned Holy Roman Emperor by Pope Benedict XIII. In 1022 St. Henry assisted Pope Benedict VIII in holding the Council of Pavia, which promoted clerical celibacy & sought to end simony (the buying and selling of ecclesiastical goods & offices). During his reign, St. Henry used his wealth & position for the Church. He confirmed Benedict's authority over Rome, was a patron of churches & monasteries, supported the Cluniac Reforms, restored episcopal sees, & founded the Diocese of Bamberg where he built a cathedral. St. Henry died in July of 1024 and was canonized in 1146 by Pope Eugene III.

Forgiveness

The virtue of forgiveness is described to us in detail by Jesus in the Gospel of Matthew, Chapter 18, he tells Peter that he must forgive his brother "not 7 times, but 77 times" before relating the parable of the unforgiving servant. Here we see that exercising forgiveness is an absolute requirement of the Christian life. What we have received from God through no merit of our own, we must likewise extend to others.

Forgiveness is love in action — if we find it hard to practice, that means we're doing it right. The Catechism says that forgiveness "bears witness that...love is stronger than sin" (CCC 2844) & points out that it "is not in our power not to feel or to forget an offense; but the heart that offers itself to the Holy Spirit turns injury into compassion & purifies the memory in transforming the hurt into intercession." (CCC 2843)
