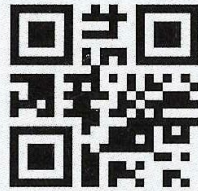

Only Peter Has the Answer

"What do you think of the Pope?"

After the election of Pope Leo XIV in 2025, all my non-Catholic (and Catholic) friends texted me this question. The result of the papal conclave was dominating the news cycle, & everyone was curious about this man, making me temporarily popular with people who apparently need more (and better) Catholics in their lives.

In today's Gospel, we see Jesus entrust Peter & his heirs with the stewardship of the kingdom here on earth, creating an unbroken line of authority that stretches through the millennia all the way to our current Pope.

I don't know if you like the Pope, your local bishop or pastor. If a friend texted you, "What do you think of him?" How you would respond? All I know is this: it doesn't really matter. What really matters is what we would say if a friend texted us the same question about Jesus Christ: "What do you think of him, & why?"

In today's Gospel, Jesus doesn't ask his disciples to take an IQ test. He doesn't try to find out who is the nicest, the hardest worker, the most humble, or even the holiest. He asks a simple question: "Who do you say that I am?"

Peter has the answer.

I am not Catholic because I like the Pope nor because the human representatives of the Church have anything to offer me (they often do, but this is beside the point). I am Catholic because only Peter has the answer.

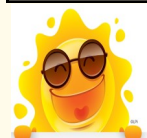

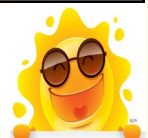

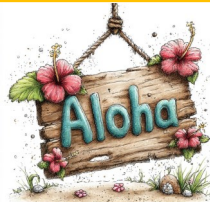

Raising faithful children is no easy task. For St. Monica, it seemed nearly impossible. Her husband wasn't a Christian and often mocked her faith. Their son, Augustine, fell quickly into wild ways. He and his friends drank, stole, and caroused throughout town. Monica never stopped praying for Augustine, no matter how far he strayed. Augustine became swept up in heresy, a false form of Christianity. He lived with a mistress and had a child out of wedlock. All the while, Monica kept praying. Conversion came slowly to Augustine, but at age 32, he was finally baptized. Augustine would go on to become a priest, then bishop, then world-renowned theologian whose works have stood the test of time. May St. Monica and St. Augustine inspire us to never stop praying for our loved ones.
