

Tactical Emergency Casualty Care - Law Enforcemnt Officer (TECC-LEO)

Florida TEMS, Inc. is proud to provide this Law Enforcement curriculum, TECC for Law Enforcement Officers and First Responders (TECC-LEO): An 8-hour course specifically designed for law enforcement officers and other non-EMS first responders. The course covers materials found in the 16-hour TECC provider course at a level appropriate for first responders. It includes 8 hours of content, which includes interactive lectures, skill stations, and patient simulations. Upon successful completion of the course, students receive a certificate of completion, a wallet card recognizing them as a TECC-LEO provider for 4 years, and 8 hours of CAPCE credit for qualified participants.

Topics include: Immediate hemorrhage control, chest and blast injuries, basic airway control, wound for treating and extracting wounded responders in high threat environments; caring for pediatric patients; and techniques for basic and advanced lifts, dragging and carrying victims to safety with ground/vehicle and Med-Evac platforms

Direct Threat

Care and extraction that is rendered while under direct contact or threat in adverse conditions

Indirect Threat

Care that is rendered while the threat has been neutralized or contained but may resurface at any point

Tactical Evacuation

Care and methods utilized/rendered while the casualty is being evacuated

At the core of TECC-LEO; the focus is on the medicine during these phases of care and provides guidelines for managing trauma in the tactical or hazardous environment. While TECC has a tactical context, it takes an all-hazards approach to providing care outside the normal operating conditions of most SWAT and Tactical Medic Teams, such as responding to a mass casualty or active shooter event.
