As so many of you already know, Edgar & Trina Ann Atzin were the victims of a domestic-violence shooting which took their lives and injured another.

Two lives lived as one... We were introduced to Edgar & Trina by way of photos and the words spoken during their eulogies... Not the ideal way you want to meet someone. Attendance at their service at Messinger's in Scottsdale on August 1 was standing room only; with the outer rooms and hallways holding the overflow.

The Patriot Guard Riders' flag line paid respect to this fallen Marine and his lady; greeting the attendees upon arrival. Their bike was on display in the foyer, along with many photos.

Throughout the service, we heard stories of a life lived large; filled with love and laughter. A slideshow presentation shared images and bits of history captured. We learned of their zest for life... how well they were loved, admired, and appreciated. Edgar was well-respected and held in high regard by co-workers. They will both be deeply missed.

Their flag-draped casket was carried in a motorcycle-drawn hearse and escorted by the Patriot Guard Riders to National Memorial Cemetery on Cave Creek Road, in Phoenix. Military services rendered there included a 21-gun Salute, Taps, and Flag Presentation.

family and loved ones of this couple taken too soon. They touched so many in their lives that they will never truly be gone. Their spirit remains, in the hearts and memories of all those whom they have touched during their time here.
