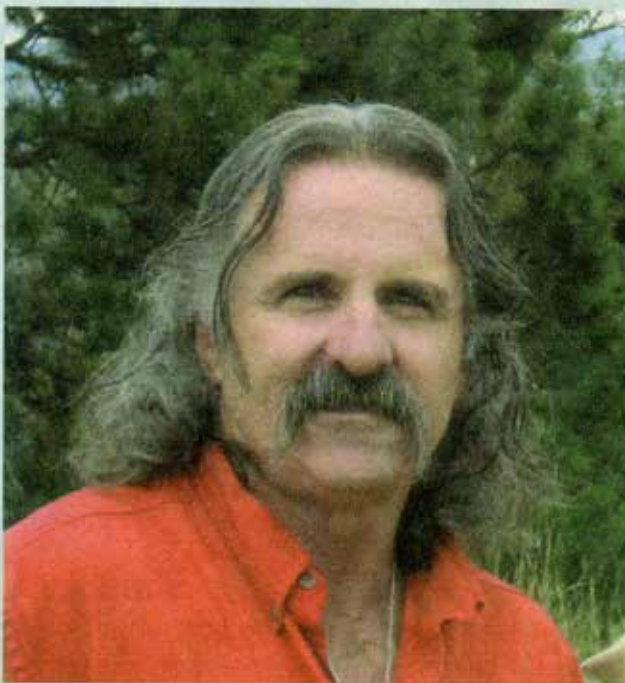
Rest in Peace
