I write with some concern regarding an article that appeared in The Mail today (14th April 2020) which reported that female prison officers have been raped by inmates who self-identify as trans-women:

In the circumstances I wonder whether you might be able to answer the following questions please:

- Which transwomen assaulted female prison staff?
- In which prisons?
- In what circumstances?

- How many female prison staff have been victims of such attacks?
