Meagher noted that the CEA was amended to remove the barrier providing a 13th check to retirees and widows in both funds following NOMERS decision to provide a similar payment to its retirees. As discussed with the Administration, a 13th check in the same as the NOMERS payment will be paid to members of the New and Old systems to offset the effect of inflation. The estimated cost of the payment is approximately \$600,000 annually and will be paid out of current assets. Like the NOMERS payment, members will receive \$500 on or around December 15, 2024 and 2025.

MOTION: Moved by Meagher and seconded by Gaal to approve the payment of a 13th check on or around December 15, 2024 and 2025 in the amount of \$500 each.
