- *Safety course has to be canceled due to low interest. Will look to try again next May.
- *Banners - We will order the banners from the same company that we currently get our decals and membership cards from. Their quote was \$580 for 10 banners. JETT in Boonville quoted \$900.

New business

- *Nancy Wrona (current member) ask for a donation from the club for the Brantingham Snowmobile Club (Sno Mads). Motion made by Neil Pepper for a \$40.00 donation of a duffle bag with a second by Michael Mabunay.
- *AED purchase - Larry Smith checked with Bob Mackenzie and he in favor of the idea but stated that it needs to be compatible with surrounding area AED's. Signage would need to be placed directing folks to where it is located. Possible location is the Brantingham Station General Store.
- *Julie Smith asked about the planning of the annual picnic. No plans have been made yet.
- *Mike L suggested we get a donation of hot dogs, rolls, soda and water and set a booth

up by the Drive-In and hand them out on Labor Day weekend.
