Meeting Minutes  
September 4, 2021

President Pepper called to order at 9:00 AM at the Brantingham Inn followed by the Pledge.

Secretary's Report:

Treasurer's Report:

- Copies of the treasurer's report were made available and our current balance is \$7500.04. Marty Roshevsky made a motion to accept the treasurer's report with a second by Mike Janis.

Old Business:

- Neil Pepper reported a small group will be traveling to Pennsylvania September 20-24. With regards to our initiative, Larry Smith indicates he has not yet heard back from Kelly Kovach. Mike Leviker wants the club to give \$1000 to Parks & Rec for signs. After much discussion, Mike needs to obtain an itemized list of signs and the cost, as was previously decided on at the August meeting, before we allocate these funds.

New Business:

- Larry Dolhof, Chairman of the Lewis County Board of Legislators was present and discussed the money the county received from the economic stimulus package. Of the \$5 million received, \$1.5 million will be going to recreation. The county is trying to buy a defunct railroad bed for a multi-use trail. \$200,000 will go toward a fund to repair roads used during SNIRT. Highways Departments can issue special use permits and that is being discussed. It was also noted that JCC does a survey on ATV/UTV use and economic impact to the area.
- Mike Leviker suggested we pay Parks & Rec \$500 for stone that was placed along Brantingham Road to fix the moguls. Neil suggests we wait to see what our final bills are before we give money to Parks & Rec.
- Cliff Johnson presented the slate of officers for the October election. Neil Pepper, President; Cliff Johnson, Vice President; Larry Smith, Treasurer; Julie Smith, Secretary, and for the Board of Director 3 year term, Scott Koch,
