Camelot Homes Breaks Ground at Villas II Luxury Golf Community

On Tuesday, September 9th, Camelot Homes broke ground at Villas II, the second phase of its premier 23-home lock-and-leave community of single-family detached residences within the prestigious, critically acclaimed Seven Desert Mountain golf community. The Camelot team was joined by Mayor Lisa Borowsky and representatives from Desert Mountain Club and the Scottsdale Chamber of Commerce as they turned the ceremonial shovels of dirt to kick off construction of the new luxury community.

In 1986, developer Lyle Anderson partnered with Frank Lloyd Wright's Taliesin Associated Architects to develop 8,300 acres into what is known today as one of the nation's most prestigious master-planned communities – Desert Mountain. Seven Desert Mountain, the luxury golf community within Desert Mountain, officially broke ground in 2018, and in 2019, No. 7 at Desert Mountain became the first new golf course to be built at Desert Mountain in nearly two decades, joining six Championship Jack Nicklaus Signature Courses.

"At Villas II, every homesite backs up to No. 7 at Desert Mountain, the USGA-rated championship par-54, 18-hole golf course that serves as the focal point of the

community," said Julie Hancock, Managing Director and Co-owner of Camelot Homes.

Villas II brings back two award-winning floor plans from the sold-out first phase of Camelot's Villas community, designed by award-winning architect Robert Hidey Architects. Each plan includes 2 to 4 bedrooms, 3.5 to 4.5 bathrooms, and 2,768 to 3,305 square feet. Homeowners may choose from three types of membership at the world-renowned private Desert Mountain Club (subject to membership approval). Depending on the membership type, benefits include access to the newly renovated Sonoran Spa and Fitness Center, a tennis complex, 25 miles of private hiking and biking trails, six Jack Nicklaus Signature championship par-72 golf courses, the championship par-54 course at Seven Desert Mountain, and 10 distinctive restaurants and grills.

"With homes set against the rolling green hills of the golf course, plus world-class amenities and easy access to recreational opportunities at nearby Tonto National Forest and Bartlett Lake, Villas II represents a rare opportunity, and the last chance to own a new home at Seven Desert Mountain," said Hancock.

Do We Really Grip The Club Like We Grip a Little Bird?

I've heard it, you've heard it, we've all heard it a million times. Don't grip the club firmly. Grip it soft, like a little bird you don't want to fly away. It's a "famous SAM SNEAD-ISM" that isn't entirely true.

It's not that pros are lying, of course. It's that they're describing something they're feeling, not what's happening.

Titleist Performance Instute (TPI) has shared their findings. Tour players have incredible gripping strength. When TPI measures them on a dynamometer, they can exert about 60 kg of maximum force. Amateurs, by contrast, usually only exert about 30 kg of maximum force.

When it's time to hit a shot, pros won't grip the club as firmly as they possibly can, though, which is why they often tell people they're gripping softly. But even though they think they're gripping the club softly, they're not. By any normal standards, pros grip the club firmly.

Think of it like a body builder lifting a 75-pound weight. To the body builder, the 75-pound weight probably feels light, even though if we tried to pick up the same weight it would feel borderline impossible. The body builder may say the weight is light, and that picking it up is easy, but you know they're just saying that because they're a super-strong body builder.

The body builder thinks the weight is light, even though it's heavy, and pro golfers think they're gripping the club softly, even though they're gripping firmly.

This is a big reason why LPGA and PGA pros hit the ball so far. They may only be using about half of their maximum grip strength, but if an amateur golfer tried to match them, they'd need to grip the club as hard as they could because pros are so much stronger.

We demonstrate in our lessons with an alignment stick holding it like you are swinging a baseball bat making a loud swish throughout the swing. And communicate holding the club with a firm grip keeping wrists, elbows, shoulders (your joints) and neck relaxed and loose as a way of increasing your swing speed to hit the ball longer and straighter.

How to Improve Your Grip Strength

All of this is a way of saying, simply, that grip strength is important. You should probably be gripping the club firmer than you are already and be actively trying to improve your grip strength in



the meantime. How do you do that? It's actually quite simple: Lift heavy stuff.

Better Business Bureau and Banner MD Anderson to Bring The BIG Pink Bus

According to statistics, breast cancer is the most diagnosed form of cancer for women in Arizona. This year, it is estimated that more than 7,000 women throughout the state will be diagnosed with breast cancer.

While a mammogram is the only screening test that has been proven to reduce breast cancer deaths through early detection, only 64% of Arizona women get their mammograms, and that percentage drops even lower for minority women and women who live in underserved communities.

To help women get access to this crucial health test, BBB Pacific Southwest, Central & Inland California (BBB), in conjunction with Banner MD Anderson Cancer Center, is hosting a mammogram screening event on Thursday, October 30th, 2025.

The mammogram screening event will take place inside Banner MD Anderson's mobile mammography unit, the BIG Pink Bus from 9:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., outside of the BBB office at the corner of N. 10th St. and E. Missouri Ave., in Phoenix.

Up to 30 women can schedule a 3D mammogram at the event. Women must be 35 years of age and older and not currently experiencing any issues with their breasts.

For women who have health insurance, the screening mammogram will be billed to their respective insurance company. If the patient is not insured, there will be a Banner Health Social Worker at the event who can discuss financial assistance.

"My mother is a breast cancer survivor, and after being diagnosed myself last fall, this cause became even more personal. I'm now fortunate to be a survivor too, and other women aren't so fortunate and don't always prioritize their own health," said Vicky Lockett, BBB's Associate Vice President, Stakeholder Engagement. "BBB wanted to change that by creating an opportunity for our team members and their families to prioritize screenings. That's why BBB is thrilled to host the amazing team at Banner MD Anderson. Hosting mammogram events like these allows us to support not only our staff, but invite our accredited businesses and neighbors to join by making early detection more accessible, and encourage women to prioritize their health."

Easy access to mammograms, known to reduce breast cancer deaths by 30% to 40%, is critical. Digital Breast Tomosynthesis Mammography, or 3D mammography, has quickly become the gold standard, offering greater accuracy, and finding more cancers than conventional mammography, including detecting invasive cancers sooner.

"The mobile unit provides a seamless entry point to Banner MD Anderson's nationally recognized Comprehensive Breast Cancer Program," said Dr. Danielle Summers, breast radiology section chief at Banner MD Anderson. "All mammograms are interpreted by our radiologists, and patients needing further treatment will have expedited access to Banner MD Anderson's specialized breast oncologists and surgeons."

Appointments are required to take part in the event at the mammogram event on October 30th. To schedule an appointment, please call (602) 521-3838.


Runnin' for the Brats Returns to Tempe Town Lake for The 52nd Annual Four Peaks Oktoberfest






First-Ever Army vs. Navy Matchup at Bentley Scottsdale Polo Championships

The two teams will square off at noon Saturday, November 8th at WestWorld of Scottsdale (16601 N Pima Road, Scottsdale), adding a patriotic element to the two-day event taking place ahead of Veterans Day. While the matchup promises fierce competition, it also gives attendees a chance to tip their hats to America's men and women in uniform while gaining a front-row seat to this historic rivalry.



"We're coming to Scottsdale for the fun, competition and camaraderie of playing on such a big stage, but we're also here to shine a spotlight on our active service members and veterans in need," said U.S. Army Major Mark Liarikos, who will play for the Army team. "With Veterans Day right around the corner, this match is about more than just polo – it's about honoring those who serve and showing them how this sport – and the horses involved in it – can help heal and connect our community."

Liarikos, the organizer of Army vs. Navy match, is a 20-year Army veteran whose service started in the Massachusetts Army National Guard and now serves as a Civil Affairs Officer and Battalion Executive Officer for the Phoenix Army Recruiting Battalion. Liarikos is also the founder of the AV (Active & Veterans) Polo Club, a nonprofit that provides equine therapy and other services and seeks to expand access to the sport for military members and veterans, including those with disabilities or limited resources.

Joining Liarikos on the Army Polo Team is Terrence Donahue, who served as a Cavalry

Officer in the U.S. Army before spending more than five years in the 82nd Airborne Division based in Fort Bragg, North Carolina. He has since served his country as everything from a platoon leader and executive officer to an aidede-camp, ultimately concluding his active military service after a 2015 deployment to northern Iraq. Donahue continues to serve as a reserve Army Officer, and the lifelong polo player also works for the Department of Homeland Security, where he continues to uphold his commitment to protecting the United States and its people.

Rounding out the Army Polo Team is retired Field Artillery Officer William J. Waggoner, who will join Donahue in one of the weekend's six highly anticipated matchups. Waggoner served during Desert Storm I and later founded World Aid Runners (WAR), a non-governmental organization that delivers ambulances to wartorn areas in the Ukraine.

In 2024, he personally drove one such vehicle from Kraków to a village near the Russian border. A polo player for more than 15 years, he recently married Cecille Visser and is now the father of six.



Playing for the opposing side is Blandon "Nalu" Pitzel, whose polo career began in 2015. Pitzel enlisted in the Navy ahead of his 18th birthday and eventually completed college while serving in the Navy Reserve. Commissioned in the Marine Corps., he flew helicopters in Hawaii and then continued to serve as a commanding officer of his G-IV squadron after completing active duty.



"We bring the same intensity to the sport and the polo field that we do to our respective branches of service," said Pitzel, noting that this will be his team's first appearance at the Bentley Scottsdale Polo Championships. "While we're all here to win, we're also proud to be here honoring our history and putting on a show for our fans in Arizona.'

Joining Pitzel on the polo field for the Navy team will be Oscar Chacon-Hidalgo, an El Paso, Texas native whose family's decorated military history includes Army, Navy and Vietnam War service. Today, Chacon-Hidalgo channels those



values into entrepreneurship and philanthropy, investing in causes and efforts that strengthen and broaden opportunities within the communities he serves.

Chris "Kit" Jones, a U.S. Marine Gunnery Sergeant and longtime polo professional, will round out the Navy team's roster.

Currently serving as the Company Senior Enlisted Advisor for MWSS 473 Detachment Alpha in Lemoore, California, Jones previously traveled the country as a combat shooting and marksmanship instructor before representing the Marine Corps Polo Team for more than 15 years in tournaments across the U.S. and around the globe. Based in Dallas, Jones is also the CEO of Dark Horse Fleet Services and plays out of the Prestonwood Polo Club.

In addition to the Army vs. Navy match, spectators can catch teams from Arizona, Louisiana, California, Tennessee, Wales and England. Sunday's festivities will also include a "Battle of the Sexes" matchup at 11:00 a.m. and an "International All-Stars" showdown at 1:00 p.m.

While the six highly anticipated polo matches promise plenty of on-field action, the Scottsdale

Charles Sidi, his wife Sarah, and their two young sons moved from England to Arizona nearly 20 years ago and fell in love with the Arcadia neighborhood immediately. Since then, Charles has established deep roots in the area. While stuck at home sick, scrolling Instagram a few months ago, he noticed a flood of podcasts on his feed and thought, wasn't there a more exciting way to conduct an interview than just sitting in chairs with microphones? That question sparked the idea for his new show, Ride Around Arcadia.



He called up the production team at Pixelist Media, and within weeks, had a green screen and stationary bicycles set up in The Brokery's Arcadia office, and was booking guests.

"Each interview lasts 5-7 minutes. After recording, the team edits the video to create a backdrop of a virtual bike ride through the beautiful Arcadia neighborhood."

Sidi says his goal with the Ride Around Arcadia podcast is to highlight the people and businesses who make up the fabric of the community so others can see what the neighborhood has to offer. The show, which launched July 14th, features a new guest each week. Bring the West's Most Notorious Outlaw Back to Life

'The Resurrection of Billy the Kid'

Western Spirit: Scottsdale's Museum of the West is pleased to announce a partnership with True West Magazine to bring The West's most well-known and notorious outlaw figuratively back to life in the exhibit The Resurrection of Billy the Kid opening October 4th, 2025.

The exhibition, which is part art show, part séance and part showdown, will explore, explode and reimagine the legend of Billy the Kid in a series of electric and eclectic pieces created by three noted artists: Bob Boze Bell, Thom Ross and Buckeye Blake.

For example, Bell's high-voltage historical paintings that depict what "really" happened in his short, dramatic life will be on display, along with Ross' surreal reimagining of the Kid's life as a fevered frontier dance.

The end of the exhibit features a haunting, life-size sculpture of Billy on his death bed by Blake, staged like a wake complete with candles, curtains, and a guest book for mourners.

To accompany the exhibition, Western Spirit will also screen ten classic Billy the Kid movies in its newly-renovated Piper Theater. Titles include Young Guns, Pat Garrett and Billy the Kid, and Old Henry.

Born Henry McCarty in 1859, Billy the Kid was an American outlaw and gunfighter in the Old West. He died in Fort Sumner, New Mexico on July 14th, 1881 at the age of 21 after being shot and killed by Sheriff Pat Garrett.

"Billy the Kid may have died young, but his legend lives on," said Andrew Patrick Nelson, Chief Curator at Western Spirit. "This exhibition and film series confront both history and the fantasy of one of the West's most complex and fascinating outlaws." The new exhibit at Western Spirit, located at 3830 N. Marshall Way in Scottsdale, will open on October 4th, 2025 and run December 31st, 2025 showcasing 20 paintings and two sculptures.

Monsoon Rains Causing Mosquitoes and Termites to Turn Up Across the Valley


Monsoon season has kicked up more than dust and rain...the experts at Burns Pest Elimination are reminding customers that they also stir up unwanted pests, including mosquitoes and termites.

"Historically, it's the second rain fall that always brings out mosquitoes and termites, as the higher moisture in the soil signals to them that it's safe to start a new colony," said Austin Burns of Burns Pest Elimination. "To keep their numbers down it's important to do some post-storm checks around the home."

Burns added that it's vital to decrease the amount of bugs after a monsoon storm by checking around the yard for any buckets, toys, etc. that

could potentially gather rainfall and quickly become a breeding ground for mosquitoes.

"Remember mosquitoes kill more people than anything else, and this is especially important to remember now as West Nile Virus and Chikungunya



The team of experts at Burns Pest Elimination is also warning of not just an uptick in mosquitoes post-rain storms but crickets and termites as well. "Some common signs of termite activity include things like mud tubes, damaged wood, or discarded wings," said Mike Boyle with Burns Pest Elimination. "Colonies can form quickly and seeing a termite swarm is a big red flag."

Termite swarms are when winged termites (called alates) leave their home in search of a mate. "A swarm looks alarming, as it's generally hundreds of flying termites in what looks like a cloud of flies, but thankfully it only lasts for about an hour," Boyle added.

As for crickets, the team at Burns recommends clearing natural debris around the home, limiting bright lights in the evenings and using dehumidifiers where necessary to remove excess moisture from the air.
