Terrarium Care Card

Thank you for choosing Unjaided Designs. To ensure the longevity of your special terrarium, please follow these care instructions:

Watering:

Terrarium watering varies between type - open vs closed. Open terrariums will need regular watering whereas closed terrariums can go weeks without needing watered. The best way to tell if your terrarium needs watering is checking the plants and soil. If the plants are starting to wilt or droop, it's time for a drink. Another way to tell is to feel the soil with your finger or using a moisture meter to see if the soil is dry. Open terrariums typically need a good drink at least once a week. But he careful to not overwater. Using a spray bottle or turkey baster is the best way to prevent overwatering. Aim the water at the hase of the plant to ensure you get the roots and spray a hit around the edges. If you feel you've overwatered your terrarium, keep the lid off for a few days to allow some water to evaporate. Use filtered or spring water to keep the glass clean.

Misting:

Closed terrariums naturally keep in a lot of moisture causing a greenhouse effect and a nice humid environment for your tropical plants and moss. Open terrariums however will need misted regularly to add humidity and keep your moss happy. Again, use filtered or spring water so you don't get water spots on the glass.

Store properly:

Place your tropical terrarium in bright, indirect light. If you've purchased a succulent terrarium however, place in bright, direct light.

Succulents will stretch if they are not receiving enough light.

Maintenance:

Since plants are living organisms, sometimes things go wrong. The best way to prevent this is checking in on your terrarium from time to time, keeping up with watering, and cleaning out any dead leaves or plants.

Remember, with proper care, your terrarium will continue to grow and flourish for years to come!
