What You Will Do

LCSW will provide a range of psychological assessment, diagnostic, and therapeutic services for children, youth, and adults. In addition to psychotherapy, you will prepare treatment plans, discharge plans, follow-up care guidance, and provide therapeutic crisis intervention and emergency services as required.

Specific Responsibilities include:

- Provide appropriate evidence-based psychotherapy with individuals, groups and families
- Conduct psychosocial assessments and updates as needed
- Conduct intakes and assist in coordinating placements in residential programs
- Develop appropriate goal focused, person centered, treatment plans containing measurable goals and objectives; obtaining client and other stake holder (guardians, family members) input as appropriate
- Maintain communication as needed with external treatment teams and professionals
- Participate in quality and compliance reviews
- Maintain accurate and timely client files and assure records comply with all applicable standards

- Complete daily billing
- Provide input for program planning
- Follow AHT's mission statement and core values
- Abide by the National Association of Social Workers (NASW) Code of Ethics guidelines
