### Holy Cross Voters' Assembly Sunday, April 18, 2021

The chairman called the meeting to order at 10:04 am, followed by a prayer from Pastor Scheer.

The minutes of the regularly scheduled Voters' Assembly on Sunday, November 8, 2020, were not read, but the chairman suggested we take them home and read them. If there are any questions about the minutes, please call him. From now on, he intends to post the minutes on the church website.

New Members: no one applying for membership.

Letters and Communications: none.

#### Reports of Pastor

Pastor's Report - report attached.

In regard to letters and communications, he has received correspondence from Peter Frantz regarding our support of the Anglican Frontier Ministry through the Great Commission funds. Pastor will include some of the information in the Holy Crossings in the future.

Confirmation: Five will be confirmed on June 6: Alexis Burnside, Morgan and Mason Outrich, Jack Palcie, Katie Poppe.

#### Principal

Finances: the school will end with a surplus.

Auxiliary Service Funds disbursements which have been controlled by the Cleveland School Board can now be used more freely without having to account as much to the Cleveland School District. There are still some restrictions, but not as stringent as before.

Reports are that voucher money will be increased from \$4000 to \$6000 next year.

EANS Funds: We are expected to receive \$85,000. Pastor intends to use this for personnel changes.

Enrollment for next year is expected to increase possibly due to some changes in the status of Luther Memorial School which is leaving the Mt. Calvary facility.

Lutheran West will be starting a middle school, grades 6-8, in 2022-2023. At this time, there are some reasons to believe that this will not affect the enrollment at other Lutheran elementary schools, including ours.

In response to a question regarding the future education of Peterson Scholarship students, Pastor Scheer said that they would progress to a special education school in Parma.

Chairman's Report: no report. No questions from anyone.

**Board of Elders Report**: no official report. The board will meet virtually this Tuesday, April 20. It has met and reorganized with Dan Kenney as the new chairman.

**Board of Christian Education Report**: no official report. This board will meet before Confirmation Sunday to discuss plans to honor the confirmands.

### Board of Property Report: attached.

The back steps to the Educational-Fellowship Building are in need of repair. This issue will have to be addressed in the next few years.

The garage door is broken and will not close tightly. This needs to be fixed.

Locks should be changed. We have a new lawnmower with garage not secure. The church building itself is not secure due to the number of outstanding keys.

Ed will pick a Saturday to ask for volunteers to help with clean-up and other things that need to be done around the property. Pastor Scheer thinks that this would be a good time for Christian fellowship among the members. Question regarding the Eternal Light: We are no longer able to get one to fit our holder. Ed and Pastor said they would research the expense of a new one.

When asked if we could solicit donations for the parking lot (a cost of \$5700.00), Larry said that he will bring it up at the next Board of Directors and/or Board of Elders' meeting.

### **Standing Committees**

Financial Secretary's Report for first quarter of 2021: attached and accepted.

Treasurer's Report for first quarter of 2021 and March monthly reports: attached and accepted.

Larry stated that he will discuss the status of the Lutheran Church Extension Fund mortgage at the next Board of Directors' meeting.

Finance Committee: no report. All matters have been handled through the Board of Directors.

Great Commission Committee: Dan Kenney reported that the last distribution should be made by the end of April, leaving a balance of \$20,000 for future use.

Constitution Committee: An impasse has been reached. Larry will see if the Board of Directors can amend the current constitution and by-laws to use as we are currently operating or to fit our current situation as a congregation.

## Ad Hoc Committees, Delegates, and Other Groups

Nominating Committee (elect 5): Since we have not yet revised the current constitution, we are still required to have a Nominating Committee of 5. Ed Himmelein, Pastor Scheer, and Larry Onesky volunteered to serve. With no other volunteers, the requirement of five will have to be waived.

Because nominees for office need to be voting members, all those selected, if not voters, will be encouraged to attend the November Voters' Assembly for eligibility purposes because his/her term of office won't begin until January of 2022.

#### Delegates and Other Groups

Holy Cross Lutheran School and Preschool: only positive comments heard about both from parents and staff.

Lutheran High School Association: Holy Cross Lutheran School will have two students going to Lutheran West next school year. These two will receive tuition assistance from the church. One other family has submitted an application for Pastor's signature, but he has some question regarding their qualification for tuition assistance from the church. He intends to discuss this in more detail at the Board of Elders' meeting.

Unfinished and New Business: none.

General Welfare (Open Forum): no comments or concerns.

Acceptance of New Members: no one applying for membership.

**Adjournment:** Ed Himmelein moved that the meeting be adjourned. The motion was seconded and passed. The meeting was adjourned at 10:58 AM.
