THE 100 CLUB EXPLAINED

For those of you unfamiliar with this concept, the idea is that 100 Club participants 'buy' numbers between 1 and 100. Each month a draw takes place and a prize is awarded for the number drawn. Although we very much hope this will raise money for the band, we also hope it will be a better investment than normal lottery tickets!

To become a 100 Club participant and obtain a number (between 1 and 100) will cost just £12 (one pound per month for a year). There is a prize draw every month. Initially we are limiting the allocation of numbers to a maximum of 2 per member.

Half of the money raised for each month will go to the band and half will be used for prize money. The size of the prize will depend on the number of participants (up to a maximum of 100). For example, assuming all numbers are eligible to be drawn, the prize money each month will be £50.

Entries can be purchased by anyone 18 years or over.

HOW TO JOIN

Payment is due annually in advance. If you would like to join the 100 Club please fill out the Application Form on page 3. There are three ways in which you can pay:

Cash or cheque – please make cheques payable to '**Crumpsall Concert Band**'. Please remember to include any payments in an envelope.

PayPal – by visiting the **SUPPORT US!** page of the Band website and making payment via the relevant Paypal button.

Bank transfer– by making a single payment to the bank account on the Application Form.

Once you have completed your form, please hand it to an official of the Band marked for the attention of '**The 100 Club Coordinator**'.

Numbers will be allocated at random as they become available. Members will be issued with an annual reminder when it is time to renew membership of the 100 Club. If members fail to renew their payments after 12 months, their respective numbers will become available to potential new members.

RULES

1. The object of the 100-Club is to raise funds for the Band.
2. The 100-Club will be run under the supervision of the Band Committee.
3. The club is open to all potential members 18 years of age or older.
4. Members must fill in an application form.
5. Entry will be by subscription of a multiple of £12 (£1 per month per number), paid in advance (by cash, cheque, PayPal or bank transfer) for a full year. Subscriptions must be paid by 5th April each year to qualify.
6. Members may have more than one number. Holding each number costs £12 for the year. Members will be informed of their numbers once they are allocated.
7. The first draw will take place on the 22nd April 2020. All subsequent monthly draws will take place between the 14th and 28th of each month. The draw will take place in the band rehearsal room.
8. The relevant numbers of all paid up members will be entered in the draw for each month.
9. The draw will comprise the selection of one number picked out at random. This will always be overseen by at least two members of the Band Committee. The holder of the number will win a prize.
10. The regular monthly prize money will be 50% of the monthly income.
11. New members will be admitted when numbers become available.
12. A waiting list will be maintained and numbers will be offered to the first person on the list when they become available.
13. Registers will be kept recording the contact details of each member, the number(s) allocated to them and the subscriptions(s) received from them.
14. Towards the end of each 12 month period, members will be contacted to ask if they wish to renew their membership.
15. Unless otherwise advised, a member will be deemed to have left the Club if his or her renewal of subscription remains unpaid after the next due date 5th April.
16. If a winner cannot be contacted, the winnings will be placed into Band funds after 6 months.
17. Participants can cancel their membership of the 100 Club at any time by giving one month's written notice to the 100-Club Co-ordinator. Under no circumstances can any payments be refunded. Subscriptions from cancelled memberships will continue to be entered into draws until used up.
18. Any decision by the Band to wind up the 100-Club will also be by one month's written notice. In such a case, the remaining subscriptions will be repaid to members.
