

WINGATE BASKETBALL GOAL STANDARD
(Adopted by the Wingate BOD on January 26, 2009)

Permanent basketball goals – permanent basketball goals shall be placed on the outside side of the driveway at least halfway up the driveway starting from the house or upper side of the sidewalk. It must be kept in good repair at all times to include but not limited to the pole free from rust; the backboard free of any cracks, broken areas or fading; and the net properly hung and without any fraying or tears.

Portable basketball goals – portable basketball goals shall be placed on the outside side of the driveway at least halfway up the driveway starting from the house or upper side of the sidewalk at all times. Occasional moving to the edge the street or other repositioning is permitted however if not in immediate use the goal must be moved back to the aforementioned placement on the driveway. It must be kept in good repair at all times, to include but not limited to, the pole free from rust; the backboard free of any cracks, broken areas or fading; and the net must properly hung and without any fraying or tears. Goal must be in an upright position at all times unless placed in the garage or behind a fence. During a hurricane watch or warning, the whole goal unit must be placed in the garage.
