

# HOLLISTER R-V SCHOOL DISTRICT TRAINING PROGRAM

Are you ready to enter the competitive workforce? Enrollment is now open for our Hollister R-V School District Vocational Training Program for adults with disabilities. This course is part of our Custodial curriculum and is recognized by the MO Department of Higher Education. Total tuition funding is available.



This six-week course equips students with disabilities with the vocational and soft skills necessary to secure competitive integrated employment with the Hollister R-V School District. Classes are held Monday through Friday for four hours per day. Graduates who complete the program and meet all pre-hiring requirements are eligible to apply for part- or full-time positions paying \$15 per hour or more, with benefits for full-time employees.
