COXHEALTH TRAINING PROGRAM

Are you ready to enter the competitive workforce? Enrollment is now open for our **CoxHealth Vocational Training Program for adults with disabilities**. This course is part of our Health Care & Social Assistance Support curriculum and is recognized by the MO Department of Higher Education. Total tuition funding is available.

Overview

This six-week program teaches students the skills to successfully pursue competitive, integrated employment as Food and Nutrition Services team members. It meets Monday through Friday for four hours a day. Upon completing the program and all other pre-hiring requirements, students can apply for full- or part-time positions that pay \$15.25 per hour plus benefits.

Who Is CoxHealth?

CoxHealth is the region's only locally owned, not-for-profit health system. It is the area leader in health care and community involvement, with six hospitals, more than 80 clinics, five ERs, and nearly 14,000 employees throughout southwest Missouri.

What You Will Learn

Students will learn food prep, cart delivery and pick-up, and stocking condiment stations.



Program Requirements

To receive a job offer, students must complete the program, meet hiring requirements, and be able to stand for up to eight hours. Requirements include a TB test and seasonal flu vaccine, with exemptions available.
