Orange County Youth Council

- Typically opens in February or March
- Ideal for smaller projects
- Youth Council chooses the grant recipients
- Youth focused projects are prioritized



OCCF Unrestricted Grant Cycle

- Typically opens in March or April
- Ideal for mid-size or large projects in Orange County
- Supportive of charitable projects in Orange County



Sol Strauss Unrestricted Grant

- Typically opens in June or July.
- Ideal for mid-size projects in Paoli.
- Supportive of charitable projects in Paoli only.
- Must show how the project impacts Paoli.



Simmons - Tegarden Unrestricted Grant

- Typically opens in June or July.
- Ideal for mid-size projects in Orleans.
- Supportive of charitable projects in Orleans only.
- Must show how the project impacts Orleans.

Grants will be targeted for projects that improve the quality of life of the citizens of Orange County and fall into the following categories:

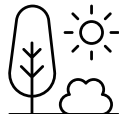
