and strengthen the relationships between infants, toddlers, and their parents. Families must meet income eligibility requirements.

Head Start is a family centered child development program for three- and four-year old. Our comprehensive services provide opportunities that help children to develop school readiness skills and assist families in recognizing their role as their child’s first and most important teacher. Nutritious meals are served daily. Transportation is provided where possible. Families must meet income eligibility requirements.

The SCICR Youth Services Bureau provides a variety of programs aimed at preventing delinquent behavior in teenagers in Orange County. Juvenile Delinquency Prevention provides evidence-based prevention curricula as part of the regular academic day for students in grades six through ten focused on improving protective factors and reducing risk factors for delinquency. Youth and Family Intervention Services provide intensive behavior monitoring and reinforcement for middle school students identified by participating schools as at risk of academic failure and delinquency due to behavioral concerns. Close coordination between the school and the family is fostered by SCICR Family Consultants assigned to individual participating schools. Intensive Case Management is a home, school, and group-based service with referrals accepted from probation departments and schools, offering services for juveniles ages twelve through seventeen and their families, at home and/or at school, both during and after school. The Youth Services Bureau also manages Safe Place for Orange County. Safe Place is a national youth outreach and prevention program for young people under the age of eighteen in need of immediate help and safety. Safe Place designates businesses and organizations as Safe Place locations, making help readily available to youth in communities across the country. Safe Place locations are marked with a yellow Safe Place sign. SCICR's Community Corrections includes Day Reporting, which offers case management services for justice-involved persons based on a risk and needs assessment. Depending on the results, our staff may provide services such as evidence-based cognitive behavioral groups, educational groups and drug testing. Referrals will be made to other service providers if appropriate. Through Community Transition, Day Reporting services are provided for men and women during the final days of their sentence to the Department of Correction and prior to their final release. SCICR staff provide a variety of cognitive behavioral groups for justice-involved persons including Thinking for a Change, Men's Non-Violence and substance abuse education groups. These groups may take place in county jails as well as with groups on the outside. With Community Services Restitution, justice-involved persons are ordered to complete a specified number of community service hours. Work is provided for government or not-for-profit agencies.
