Weaving instructor, Phyllis Narus of Georgetown, Tennessee, has been weaving since 1996 and has studied with weaving enthusiasts Deborah Chandler of Guatemala, Elaine Bradley of Georgia, Beth Smathers of Oklahoma, Emily Dewhirst and Judy Smith-Rowland both of Tennessee. She is a member of the Handweavers Guild of America as well as a charter member of the Scenic Valley Handweavers Guild of Georgetown, TN Phyllis owns R\&M Yarns in Georgetown, TN (rmyarns.com) and enjoys all aspects of weaving but especially the enthusiasm and excitement of beginning weavers.

This workshop is designed for "first-time" weaving students as well as those needing a refresher on how to "dress" a loom, but has proven to be suitable for everyone. During the three-day workshop, students will complete a project from start to finish. Areas covered will be project planning, completely "dressing" the loom for weaving, correctly holding and throwing a shuttle (with an emphasis on selvage and tension control) and other topics necessary in completing a project. The class size is kept small to allow individual attention for each student. Each new student is given a reference notebook to take home which is included in the class fee. (Returning students-please bring your notebook for any new pages.) Class size is limited to 4 students and registration forms are taken on a "firstcome, first-served" basis.
