How to Register

- Registration for individual courses closes 5 business days prior to the start of each course.
- Email l.jones@kdin.ca to sign up for the course. **Important:** It is essential to register with the email address that will be used by the participant for the training in order to access the course material.
- Kildoon will send you the information you require to sign into Kildoon's MS Teams platform.
- Participants will be required to sign into the Kildoon MS Teams platform a minimum of 3 days prior to course start to complete registration and ensure that they are able to navigate through the course materials.
- Payment is due upon registration. Student withdrawal from a course with less than 5 business days notice before course start date will result in 50% cancellation fee being charged.
