IMAGINE THE SLIDE SYMMETRICALLY

Are your slides paralyzing the eye and brain? Overwhelmed with too much content, the slide strains the learner's comprehension. The Rule of Thirds designs each slide symmetrically with white space to easily absorb content:

1. Heading on the upper third.
2. Concise bulleted sentences/words in the middle third.
3. Logo or subtitle on the lower third.

Enabling Objectives
