
Psalm 23

THE SACRAMENT OF HOLY COMMUNION

- P Let us give thanks to the Lord God our Father,

- P It is indeed right and salutary that we should at all times and in all places offer thanks and praise to you, O Lord, Holy Father, through your Son Jesus Christ our Savior and Lord; who brought to light the living hope of a blessed resurrection, that, in our grief, we may rejoice in full assurance of our change into the likeness of His glory!




