

GOSPEL: St. John 10:11-18

- In language that claims the twenty-third psalm as His own, Jesus teaches that He is the One True Great Good Shepherd who cares for His sheep. Jesus teaches that He will die for His sheep, and Jesus teaches that He will also overcome death for His sheep.

- P Jesus said: ¹¹"I am the good shepherd. The good shepherd lays down his life for the sheep. ¹²The hired hand, who is not the shepherd and does not own the sheep, sees the wolf coming and leaves the sheep and runs away—and the wolf snatches them and scatters them. ¹³The hired hand runs away because a hired hand does not care for the sheep. ¹⁴I am the good shepherd. I know my own and my own know me, ¹⁵just as the Father knows me and I know the Father. And I lay down my life for the sheep. ¹⁶I have other sheep that do not belong to this fold. I must bring them also, and they will listen to my voice. So there will be one flock, one shepherd. ¹⁷For this reason the Father loves me, because I lay down my life in order to take it up again. ¹⁸No one takes it from me, but I lay it down of my own accord. I have power to lay it down, and I have power to take it up again. I have received this command from my Father."

FIRST LESSON: Acts 4:5-12

- L St. Peter and St. John had been arrested the previous day because, through the power of The Holy Spirit, they were proclaiming Jesus' Gospel Good News of His death and resurrection to the people. In today's lesson, St. Peter is once again filled with the power of The Holy Spirit so that he can proclaim salvation in Jesus' Holy Name to the religious authorities.
- The next day the rulers, elders, and scribes assembled in Jerusalem, ⁶with Annas the high priest, Caiaphas, John, and Alexander, and all who were of the high-priestly family. ⁷When they had made the prisoners stand in their midst, they inquired, "By what power or by what name did you do this?" ⁸Then Peter, filled with the Holy Spirit, said to them, "Rulers of the people and elders, ⁹if we are questioned today because of a good deed done to someone who was sick and are asked how this man has been healed, ¹⁰let it be known to all of you, and to all the people of Israel, that this man is standing before you in good health by the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, whom you crucified, whom God raised from the dead. ¹¹This

Jesus is 'the stone that was rejected by you, the builders; it has become the cornerstone.' ¹²There is salvation in no one else, for there is no other name under heaven given among mortals by which we must be saved."

SECOND LESSON: 1 John 3:16-24

L Jesus' death and resurrection on our behalf is His absolute demonstration of His Divine grace, forgiveness, love, mercy, and salvation. We are called through the power of The Holy Spirit to share Jesus' Divine grace, forgiveness, love, mercy, and salvation with others, not just through our words but especially through our actions and deeds. In sharing Jesus' Divine grace, forgiveness, love, mercy, and salvation we fulfill Jesus' commandments to love God His Father and one another.

Ought to lay down our lives for one another. ¹⁷How does God's love abide in anyone who has the world's goods and sees a brother or sister in need and yet refuses help? ¹⁸Little children, let us love, not in word or speech, but in truth and action. ¹⁹And by this we will know that we are from the truth and will reassure our hearts before him ²⁰whenever our hearts condemn us; for God is greater than our hearts, and he knows everything. ²¹Beloved, if our hearts do not condemn us, we have boldness before God; ²²and we receive from him whatever we ask, because we obey his commandments and do what pleases him. ²³And this is his commandment, that we should believe in the name of his Son Jesus Christ and love one another, just as he has commanded us. ²⁴All who obey his commandments abide in him, and he abides in them. And by this we know that he abides in us, by the Spirit that he has given us.


