It is such a joy to see the sparks in the eyes of many after we pray with them, after we ask God's blessings to come upon their homes, praying for healing and spiritual awakening. The Blessings ministry is a way we and our disciples come together to become God's hands and feet to the people around us. Some elderly whom we had been visiting earlier passed away in 2021, and we praise our God that we could pray together with them and have a hope that they are with Jesus now.

Another ministry we were engaged in this year is outreach in the Domestic **Violence Center.** Through our ministry with the social workers of our region we were invited to visit a Government shelter for women that are at risk and don't have any place to live. By providing some humanitarian aid for that center God has blessed us to make a good connection with the leaders and women that are there. Now the doors are open for us to bring the light of the Gospel to them and we pray for God to touch the hearts of many in that shelter. During Christmas we visited them with a program and gifts for children and adults, and shared about Who is the reason for the Christmas season. Social workers have asked us if we can be a help in teaching those













women and children the ethical principles that will eventually transform their lives.
