Logline

When a meticulous operating theatre assistant discovers evidence of illegal organ harvesting inside a prestigious coastal hospital, he must risk everything to expose a global medical conspiracy before he becomes the next patient to disappear.

Concept

Surgeon: Double Oath is a **clinical thriller set almost entirely within the operating theatres of a large coastal hospital.**

The film explores the terrifying possibility that the place designed to save lives could secretly be exploiting them.

The story follows **Anton Vick**, an observant operating theatre assistant who notices irregularities during routine surgeries. When a series of patients vanish from medical records and organs appear in transplant systems without donors, Anton begins uncovering a hidden criminal enterprise operating inside the hospital itself.

What begins as suspicion quickly evolves into a dangerous investigation involving corrupt surgeons, falsified donor registries, and a powerful criminal network selling organs on the global black market.

As Anton digs deeper, he discovers that the conspiracy reaches the highest levels of hospital leadership.

The only problem:

No one believes him.

And in a hospital, it's easy to make someone disappear.

Tone & Style

Hospital administrator.

Polished and respected publicly.

Secretly the operational manager of a black-market organ trafficking network.

Jed

Senior surgeon.

Highly respected in the hospital.

His surgical expertise allows him to remove healthy organs during legitimate procedures without raising suspicion.

Ash

Operating theatre supervisor.

Tough and protective of her surgical team.

She begins to suspect the hospital is hiding something — but exposing it could destroy everything she believes in.

Matty Quail

Hospital technician with a military background.

Analytical and highly strategic.

He helps Anton uncover patterns within the hospital systems.

Sue H

Hospital executive.

Quietly powerful.

She appears completely untouchable.

And she is the true architect behind the entire criminal operation.

THREE-ACT SCREENPLAY OUTLINE

ACT I — THE DISCOVERY

Opening Sequence

Coastal General Hospital during a violent nighttime storm.

Emergency surgeries fill the operating theatres.

Anton Vick works quietly among surgeons and nurses.

He is calm, precise, and observant.

Inciting Incident

During a routine surgery Anton notices something strange:

A surgeon removes an organ **that was not part of the procedure**.

The surgical report is altered afterward.

Anton begins quietly questioning the event.

First Suspicion

A patient scheduled for routine surgery dies unexpectedly.

The medical record is quickly sealed.

Anton notices:

- missing documentation
- altered surgical notes
- incorrect transplant records

Something is wrong.

ACT II — THE CONSPIRACY

Anton begins secretly investigating.

With help from Matty Quail, he uncovers disturbing evidence.

Patterns emerge:

- patients with rare blood types disappearing
- organ transport shipments leaving the hospital at night
- falsified donor records

They discover the hospital is being used as a **pipeline for illegal organ harvesting**.

Rising Danger

Someone inside the hospital realizes Anton is investigating.

He is warned to stop asking questions.

Equipment malfunctions begin targeting him.

Medical files disappear.

Security begins watching him.

Midpoint Revelation

Anton discovers the true scale of the operation:

The hospital is supplying organs to **wealthy international clients**.

And the network extends far beyond the hospital itself.

Betrayal

Anton trusts the wrong person.

Jed reveals himself as one of the surgeons performing the illegal removals.

Anton narrowly escapes an attempt to silence him.

ACT III — THE OPERATING ROOM

Final Plan

The patient is being used as a donor without consent.

The operation is already underway.

Climax

Inside the operating theatre, Anton interrupts the procedure.

Ash begins realizing Anton is telling the truth.

Security moves to remove him.

But the evidence is now undeniable.

The hospital's leadership is exposed.

Final Revelation

Just as the criminals are arrested, Anton discovers something worse:

Dan Belcher was only the middleman.

The real mastermind behind the entire operation is **Sue H.**

And she may already be planning the next hospital.

Ending

Sunrise over Coastal General Hospital.

The investigation has only begun.

Anton stands outside the hospital watching emergency helicopters land.

The system has been exposed.

But the network still exists.
