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### 1. Bartholin's Abscess

**Description**: A Bartholin's cyst is a fluid-filled lump near the vaginal opening



**Position:** Lithotomy / Arms Out / Sheet Under Patient / Towel on floor / Bluey under buttocks

**Setup:** Arm boards x 2 / Table head end removed / Table light end attached / Stirrups for legs / Warm blanket

In Room Equipment: Overhead Lights / Bair Hugger / Diathermy / Suction Canaster Tree / Peri Table (Ask Surgeon) / Stool for Surgeon

### 2. Bilateral Salpingo-oophorectomy - B.S.O

(<u>Home</u>) <u>Important</u>: Confirm all requirements with surgical team prior to setup. This includes Theatre table orientation, patient positioning and theatre equipment requirements.

Description: A bilateral Salpingo-oophorectomy is a surgery to remove both fallopian tubes and both ovaries



**Position v1:** Lithotomy / Trenguard / Arms tucked using pillowcases/ Slide sheet used to move patient into position, then removed / Towel on floor / Bluey under buttocks

Position v2: Lithotomy / Tilt Mat / Arms tucked / Slide sheet used to move patient into position, then remove / Towel on floor / Bluey under buttocks

**Setup:** Arm boards x 2 / Table head end removed / Table light end attached / Stirrups for legs / Warm blanket

## 3. Cone Biopsy of the Cervix

### 5. Ectopic Pregnancy - Laparoscopically



In Room Equipment: SCD's Machine / Bair Hugger machine / Diathermy machine (Pad on right) / Suction Canaster Tree / J Boards for leg support / Seat Belt on hand if / needed / Heal gels / Foam for catheter bag contact

### 11. Lower Uterine Segment Caesarean Section + Salpingostomy

### 12. Pelvic Mass

## 21. 3rd Degree Tear
