At time of check-in, a signed open check is required before numbers will be issued. Make all checks payable to IEHJA.

NO QUALIFYING OR MEMBERSHIP REQUIRED EXCEPT FOR MEDAL FINALS.

TRAINERS: call the stabling manager, Gretchen Clark, at (909) 798-9479 or (909)809-0131 by October 17, 2025 with your stall and shavings request. Be sure to reserve stalls and shavings on each entry as well. Stall assignments will be posted at the show office.

No refunds on stalls. Stalls can also be reserved after closing of entries and at the show office for \$300.00.

Once entered, exhibitors may add classes without penalty. Class "adds" will be accepted before the start of a class provided the proper paperwork has been completed in the Horse Show Office prior to the start of the class. Adds accepted at the back gate without the proper paperwork will be assessed an additional \$15.00 fee per class.

IEHJA accepts checks, cash and credit card. A \$30.00 fee will be charged for any returned checks.

To be eligible for the IEHJA Medal Finals on Sunday, both rider and trainer/coach must be IEHJA members in good standing. Also, medal finalists must have accumulated 10 points either by winning a medal or by placing in multiple medal classes.

Class 400 Entry fee \$60

IEHJA Flat Medal Final: Qualified riders will work as a group based on the same specifications as the IEHJA Flat Medal. A work-off of three or more riders may be required at the judge's discretion. Must incorporate at least 3 of the USEF Tests 1-14.

Class 401 Entry fee \$60

IEHJA 2'0" Medal Final: Qualifiers will ride two rounds, resulting in a combined total score. An additional work-off of two or more of the top riders, either over fences or on the flat, is required.

**TIP Classes

Class 200

Fall Festival 2'6"-3' Hunter Derby Entry fee \$60.00

Open to junior, amateur and professional riders jumping 2'6" or higher at this show. In a two-round format, horses will be judged on performance, hunter pace, jumping style, quality and movement. To be shown over Hunter Derby style courses set at 2'6", 2'9" and 3'0". The top 12 horse and rider combinations with the highest scores from the first round are eligible to return for the second round.

Scores will be combined from the first and second rounds to determine overall winners. Need NOT be a member of IEHJA to compete.

First Round

- a. The course will offer a variety of jumps with different appearances such as natural post and rail, hedge, brush, logs, hay bales and natural foliage, including 2-3 option fences for bonus points.
- b. The jumpable portion of any fence must be a minimum of 8 feet wide.
- c. There will be a minimum of 8 fences in the first round.

Second Round: Handy Hunter Round

- a. A minimum of 8 obstacles must be offered in the Handy Hunter Round.
- b. There will be 2-3 option fences for bonus points, incorporating the elements of natural obstacles.
- c. The second round will have handy options, such as tight turns, different tracks, clever options for jump approaches, hand gallop a jump, trot a lowered jump, halt, or obstacle navigation on the flat built into the course.

Prize money distributed as follows: 1^{st} -30%, 2^{nd} -25%, 3^{rd} -20%, 4^{th} -15%, 5^{th} -10%. Ribbons 1^{st} - 6^{th} .

Fall Festival Hunter Derby judged Warm-up: The Hunter Derby warm-up will be judged and will consist of a course set with Hunter Derby style fences set at 2'6". Ribbons 1st-6th.

IEHJA 2025 Awards Banquet Held at Santa Anita Park on Sunday February 15, 2026

This year IEHJA will be doing the thoroughbred high point a little different. Instead of collecting points all year we will be taking points from the year end show only. Remember for members it is double points . Meaning you must ride at the year end show if you want to be eligible for the Thoroughbred High Point . In order to receive points you must give your TIP information to the horse show office . The Thoroughbred High Point will be awarded at the 2025 banquet in February. ALSO the IEHJA year end show is TIP approved. Please see the schedule to find the classes that are TIP approved.



Exhibitor Information

Warm-ups will be held Friday 10:00am until dusk. Tickets may be purchased at the show office for \$20 per round. Each ticket will allow the exhibitor 2 minutes of schooling time in the show arena.

Back gate rules will be strictly enforced.

Double Points: The IEHJA Fall Festival Year-End Show is a double point show. Members earning points toward 2025 IEHJA Year-End Championships will earn double points for placing in all qualifying classes. Classes noted with an * do **NOT** apply to IEHJA 2025 point totals.

Show Champion and Reserve Champion ribbons and prizes will be awarded in each division. Points will be awarded as follows: Ist=IO, 2nd=6, 3rd=4, 4=2, 5th=I, 6th=.5.

Prizes will be awarded to all first place winners with ribbons to sixth.

Class eligibility and cross entry restrictions are the exhibitor's responsibility. Exhibitors may only enter classes for which they are eligible. Exhibitors must observe all cross entry restrictions.

Adds and Scratches: Class entries will be accepted, if possible, up to the start of a class provided the proper paperwork has been completed in the Horse Show Office prior to the start of the class. Adds accepted at the back gate without the proper paperwork will be assessed an additional \$15.00 fee per class.

Classes may be scratched for a full credit with the proper paperwork submitted to the Horse Show Office PRIOR to the start of the class. Exception: Medal Classes - There are NO REFUNDS for Medal Classes.

Order of go will not be imposed unless management deems it necessary due to time constraints. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to check in for their class with the back gate personnel. It is also the exhibitor's responsibility to check with the Horse Show Office or the back gate regarding changes in the show schedule. Trainer schedule conflicts brought to the attention of the back gate personnel will be resolved if at all possible.

Jumper Timed Events will use electronic timers.

Lunging area is available all day.

Braiding is optional.

Proper show attire is required. ASTM-SEI helmets are required for anyone while mounted at any time on the show grounds.

Golf Cars are permitted. Please park golf cars away from the entrance to the arena. GOLF CARS MAY ONLY BE DRIVEN BY PERSONS WITH A VALID DRIVER'S LICENSE.

Food and beverages are available all day.

Vehicle parking will be strictly enforced for your safety and protection.

Dogs are allowed at Galway Downs but must be on a leash at all times. You are required to clean up after your dog.

The Horse Show Office will be open from 7:00 a.m. on show days and close 30 minutes after the last class finishes. The office will be open Friday at 8:30 am for check-in.

A release of liability must be signed and in the office before mounting your horse.

Judge's decisions are final and are not subject to protest.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event the rider is absent, disqualified or eliminated from competition.

Trainer splits for tack stalls and shavings on trainer accounts may be split among customers by the Horse Show Office provided that the office is informed by Saturday, November 8th by 5:00 p.m.

Combining classes with fewer than three entries may occur with other similar classes at the discretion of the management.

Splitting classes with more than 20 entries may occur and a second set of ribbons may be distributed.

RV and Camper Parking with full hookups are available at the show. If interested, go to signupgenius.com. When you arrive at the show, come to the show office for space assignment.

DEADLINE FOR THE FALL FESTIVAL SHOW ENTRIES

October 24, 2025. Please complete your entry form. Include all the classes in which you plan to ride. Changes may be made in the show office at time of check-in.

A SIGNED OPEN CHECK is required at time of check-in before numbers will be issued.

Shavings must be ordered from Gretchen Clark by calling (909) 809-0131. Exhibitors may bring their own shavings. No straw is allowed.

SOME APPROVED IEHJA CLASSES ARE ALSO USHJA APPROVED

The year-end horse show will be run in accordance with USEF and IEHJA rules. Exhibitors are responsible for entering only in classes for which they are eligible. In the event that an exhibitor enters and receives an award in a class for which they were ineligible, the award must be returned for redistribution. Applicable class fees will still apply.

It is the responsibility of owners, exhibitors and their agents to respect Galway Downs Event Center. Visitors will be charged for any damage to their stalls, buildings and other properties on the show ground.

Management: The Horse Show Management reserves the right in itself to interpret all questions and conditions in regard to or arising out of, or incident to, the show without claims for damages of recourse of any kind. All questions not covered in these rules and regulations shall be decided by the Horse Show Management and their decision is final. The Horse Show Management reserves the right to itself to refuse, accept conditionally, or to cancel any entries, disqualify riders or exhibitors, prohibit claim damages, to change any course, to cancel or combine any unfilled classes, or to reschedule classes, after due notice to exhibitors.

Judge's decisions are final and are not subject to protest. Once a class has commenced, it will be run and prizes will be awarded based upon the decision of the judge. In the


event of a protest, awards may be subject to later re-distribution. Protests must be brought to the attention of the Horse Show Manager. If the protest cannot be immediately resolved at the show, the issue may be presented in the manner addressed in the IEHJA rules and regulations.

Assumption of Risk: By signing the entry form, the Owner, Parent, Guardian, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, Handler, or Longeur acknowledges that horseback riding, particularly jumping, is a dangerous activity and involves inherent risks that may cause serious injury and in some cases death because of the unpredictable nature and irrational behavior of horses, regardless of their training and past performance and expressly assumes all such inherent risks whether identified herein or on the entry form. A horse without warning or any apparent cause can buck, stumble, fall, rear, bite, kick, run, make unpredictable movements, spook, jump, step on a person's foot or push a person-all of which may cause the rider or observer to fall or be jolted, resulting in serious injury of death. A horse may also become loose and cause injury to an observer or rider or to another horse. A loose horse can run at a full gallop in a panic and run into objects or persons or other horses. The Show Ground Facilities contain roads and driveways that are traversed by cars, golf cars, tractors, trailers and heavy equipment all of which may spook a horse. The above warnings and risks are meant as an example of some of the risks that are inherent and may be encountered, but it is agreed this is not an exhaustive list and there are numerous additional conditions and/or events that may result in injuries while participating in the Competition and/or present on the Show Ground Facilities.

Minor exhibitors: Parents or Guardians of minor exhibitors shall hold harmless Galway Downs Event Center and Inland Empire Hunter Jumper Association, its officers and directors harmless for injury to such minor. No child's entry will be accepted unless a parent or guardian signs the entry form.
