





1970s reproduction brass fire department speaking trumpet. The inside of the bell is engraved TC 1990. It is unknown who the trumpet belonged to. It stands 18" tall and is in good condition.

Two fire department-themed shaving mugs. The first has "The Fireman" with the owner's name Homer B. Wyatt painted on the bottom rim. The second has a horse-drawn fire apparatus racing to a fire. Both are in good condition with no chips or cracks.

A metal match safe from the Laurel Fire Company of York PA. The safe features the Laurel owl on a celluloid insert. It measures 2" by 2 3/4". It is rough condition as the metal is quite rusted.


