Sunday 26th June – Percy's Ramble – Rainham

Meet at 11am in the car park of **Riverside Country Park, Lower Rainham,** for a flat walk alongside the Medway towards The Strand. Return to cars and back to **The Rose and Crown** for lunch at around 12.45 pm.

Wednesday 6th July - Evening Ramble - Teston Lock

Meet in the car park of Teston Lock at 5 pm for our usual mid-summer walk either side of the Medway. Back to cars and on to **The Red Start, Barming,** for dinner at around 6.45pm

Wednesday 20th July - Local Ramble - Rose & Crown Shorne
