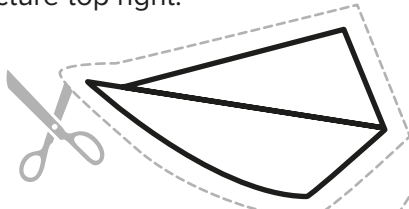
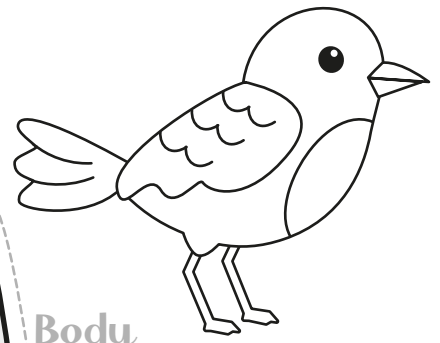


Build a Bird

Print onto thick paper or card, color all the parts of the bird and then carefully cut everything out. Add a little glue to each of the parts and attach to match the picture top right.



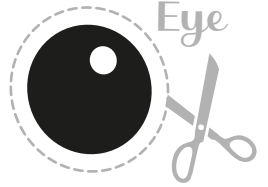
Fact

Birds use their beaks to 'zip' their feathers together creating a smooth, airtight, and waterproof surface

A bird's diet includes nectar, fruit, plants, seeds and the carcasses of other animals. They have no teeth so their digestive system is adapted to swallow food whole

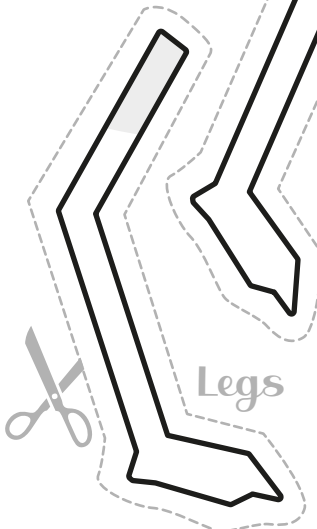
