INCLUDED IN PRICE:

1) Round trip airfare per brochure — deluxe motor coaches — First Class / Superior Class hotels — guided sightseeing — entrance fees to sites visited breakfast & dinner daily per brochure

2) Taxes and fuel charges totaling \$595 USD comprised of \$264.60 for fuel charges (subject to increase by airline up to 30 days prior to departure) and \$330.40 for taxes (including federal inspection fees for the U.S. Customs and Immigrations; international air transportation tax; agricultural tax; other per person taxes imposed by government entities; airport taxes and fees including the September 11th Security fee up to \$10 per person, passenger facility charges up to \$18 per person, federal domestic flight segment fees up to \$3.50 per segment and U.S. and International arrival and departure, and other government imposed fees up to \$300 per person).

3) Gratuities of **\$165** for tour guide or cruise director, local host, driver, local guides, and/or ships' crew; gratuities on ferries, and cruise ships.

NOT INCLUDED IN PRICE:

Not included in your package are passports, visas, COVID-19 tests, vaccinations, laundry, lunches, telephone, mini-bar, alcohol, other beverages and food outside of the contracted tour operator menu as presented at a hotel or restaurant (these extra items will be billed to you before leaving the hotel, or restaurant), airport transfers on non-qualifying flights, porterage at airports, travel insurance, excess baggage fees, any fees or fuel surcharges imposed by the airlines after the date you register for your trip, and all other items not specifically mentioned.

PAYMENT:

A full deposit of \$500 per person is required at time of registration. Credit cards are only accepted for the initial deposit. All other remaining payments must be made in the form of a check, including final payment. Final payment is due no later than 100-days prior to departure.

Registrations received after 100-days prior to departure must be accompanied by full payment. Registrations received between 90-75 days prior to departure are subject to a \$300 late fee.

Tour pricing is based on a minimum group size of <u>20 passengers to be valid</u>. The following supplements may apply for smaller groups: 19-15 travelers, \$150 per person; 14-10 travelers, \$195 per person. If group size is less than 10 travelers, the tour may be canceled due to lack of participation. If final (full) payment is not received by *imagine* Tours and Travel, I C (hereafter referred to as *imagine*) 75-days prior to departure, you will be automatically cancelled from the tour and your initial deposit of \$500 will be forfeited and additional fees may apply. imagine reserves the right to add a surcharge if the

dollar declines by more than 2% against the shekel or euro based on foreign exchange rates in effect on date (11/07/23) when your tour was booked by your tour leader/church. All payments are required in US Funds.

ACCOMMODATIONS:

Price is based on double occupancy (two persons sharing a room). When available, single rooms are often smaller than doubles. While imagine will try to match roommates, we cannot guarantee one will be available. Roommates may be assigned as late as 75 days prior to departure. If one is not available or f you request a single room, there will be a single room supplement charge of \$995 for the basic itinerary.

ITINERARY & CHANGES:

Because airlines often change flight schedules after brochures are printed, imagine reserves the right to shorten or lengthen the itinerary accordingly. You will be notified in writing when possible. If itinerary changes necessitate extra overnights, you will be charged \$195 per night/per person (single rooms \$225, night). Meals for extra nights are not included. Any changes and/or deviations from the program and/ or departure city listed, by the passenger, must be provided in writing to imagine no later than 100-days prior to departure and any extra costs incurred will be billed to the passenger. All deviations are subject to a standard fee of \$150 plus any applicable airline fees. All tours are final at 70-days prior to departure. No changes and/or additions may be made to the tour after that time.

LAND ONLY:

Land Only price is \$4,397 per person. Price does not include international flights. Land Only passengers may be responsible for transfers and/or additional overnights incurred by booking their own flights. We recommend you purchase a ticket which can be changed without large penalties, as the group's flights may change. Passengers changing from the regular tour to Land Only after 120 days prior to departure will be charged a fee of \$150 per person.

AIRLINE TICKETS:

In order to keep prices low, *imagine* does not guarantee you will be on the most direct flights to your final destination. *imagine* also does not guarantee the group will be on the same flights, particularly if registering 100 days prior to departure. Flight routings are chosen by the airlines and not *imagine*. Airline tickets cannot be changed or refunded once issued. Air transportation to/from your destination will be economy class aboard IATA and ARC carriers utilizing APEX or SUPER APEX non-refundable, non-amendable tickets for groups of 10 or more flying together for entire itinerary. *imagine* is unable to use individual frequent flyer points to upgrade or accept them as partial payment for air transportation. Deviations by the passenger, from the group's scheduled flights could result in different routings/air carriers. Airline changes, if allowable, made by the passenger after final payment has been made, may incur additional fees.

FLIGHT TIMES:

All flight times are subject to change by the airlines without advance notice. imagine is not responsible for such changes or delays and does not reimburse expenses resulting from such delays. If making your own flight arrangements to a departure city or any other portion of your trip, we recommend you purchase a ticket which can be changed without large penalties. All passengers are responsible for reconfirming their flights with the airline 24 hours prior to departure.

PASSPORT:

Each passenger is responsible for making sure that they have a **valid passport** that has an expiration date at least six months after the date of return from their trip. A copy of your valid passport must be submitted to our office by 100 davs prior to departure

VISAS:

Applicable visas will be obtained by *imagine* for U.S. and Canadian Citizens only. All passengers who do not carry U.S. or Canadian Passports will be responsible for obtaining visas to the countries they are visiting. *imagine* is not responsible for non-U.S. & Canadian Passport holders.

TRIP RESCHEDULING:

imagine and/or Trip leader reserve the right to re-schedule the dates of the Trip to future dates TBD due to governmental action, pandemic, or other circumstances beyond their control. Should that occur, all travelers will be rebooked for the new dates. Travelers unable to travel on the new dates may cancel their participation and will be assessed a cancellation fee of up to \$300 per person, plus any additional penalties/fees imposed by ground operator(s), airlines, or other vendors. Travelers can transfer to another available tour up to one year from their original departure date.

CANCELLATION FEES:

Any passenger cancelling from the day of registration to 100 days prior to departure will be charged a \$300 non-refundable administrative fee per person plus any airline penalties, if applicable. You will also be charged a single room fee if your cancellation forces your roommate into a single room from 75 days prior until the date of departure.

The following charges also apply: 99-75 days = **\$500**; 74-60 days = **\$2,750**; 59-46 days = 85% of total cost; 45 days to day of departure = 100% of total cost. All cancellations must be received in writing. On or after the day of departure there is no refund for any services not used. We strongly recommend you purchase travel insurance. If imagine cancels the tour due to lack of participation, there will be a charge of \$200 deducted from the amount refunded to each passenger for administrative fees plus any airline penalties if applicable. No changes may be made to the tour within 70-days of departure, as the tour is officially closed

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Day 1 - Monday, January 6: Depart USA

Our adventure begins as we gather for our flight to Israel. Once settled on the plane, sit back, relax, enjoy the onboard meals and entertainment as you prepare for the pilgrimage of a lifetime - walking where Jesus walked.

Day 2 – Tuesday, January 7 Arrive in Tel Aviv

Upon arrival in Tel Aviv, we will connect with our guide, who will lead us through customs. We then board our comfortable Wi-Fi-equipped motorcoach and head to our hotel in Tiberias. As we approach the city, you will behold the breath-taking beauty of the Sea of Galilee! Once settled, we will enjoy a welcome dinner and refreshing night's rest.



Day 3 – Wednesday, January 8: Caesarea Maritima, Mt. Carmel, Mt. Tabor, Valley of Armageddon, Magdala

Following breakfast, we head for Caesarea Maritima located the shore of the emerald, blue Mediterranean Sea where gladiators and chariots performed before crowds, Peter baptized the first Gentile (a Roman Centurion), and the Apostle Paul, a prisoner of Jesus Christ, made his appeal before Festus to Rome. Then on to Mt. Carmel, where the prophet Elijah prayed, and God defeated 450 prophets of Baal with fire from heaven. We then ascend the Mount of Transfiguration overlooking the Valley of Armageddon, where Peter, James, and John saw Jesus' face shining like the sun and his clothing like a flash of lightning, with Moses and Elijah appearing with him. From there, we head to Magdala on the Sea of Galilee, the home of Mary Magdalene, from whom Jesus cast out seven demons, where we will explore a recently unearthed synagogue where Jesus ministered. Following a time of reflection, we will head back to our hotel for dinner and overnight.

Day 4 – Thursday, January 9: Capernaum, Mount Beatitudes, Boat Ride on the Sea of Galilee, Caesarea Philippi

As the sun rises over the Sea of Galilee (you will not want to miss this!) we will head for the ancient city of Capernaum, which served as a headquarters for Jesus' ministry. Then on to the Mount of Beatitudes with its beautifully manicured gardens, where Jesus delivered the Sermon on the Mount. Following a boat ride on the Sea of Galilee, we will ascend to the majestic Golan Heights to visit the ancient city of Caesarea Philippi, where people worshiped Pan, a pagan god. In this place, Peter made his declaration about Jesus "Thou art the Christ, the Son of the living God." Then back to our hotel for dinner and overnight.



Day 5 – Friday, January 10: Primacy of Peter, Tabgha, Nazareth Village, Cana

Our day begins at the Primacy of Peter where the resurrected Christ while preparing bread and fish over a charcoal fire invited Peter and the disciples to "come and have breakfast" after supernaturally filling their net with fish after they had fished all night without catching anything. Then on to visit the ancient site of Tabgha, where the fishes and loaves' multiplication took place. We will then head to Nazareth, where you will experience what village life was like in Jesus' hometown. After enjoying a freshly prepared first-century meal (included), we will travel to Cana, where Jesus performed his first miracle of turning water into wine at a wedding. Then back to our hotel for dinner and overnight.

Day 6 – Saturday, January 11: Beit She'an, Jacob's Well, Jericho

Today we travel south through the Jordan Valley to visit Beit She 'an, one of the best-preserved Decapolis Roman cities, where King Saul and his sons' bodies were hung from the city walls after the Philistines defeated them. Then on to Qasr Al Yahud, where the Holy Spirit descended like a dove when John the Baptist baptized Jesus, and Jacob's Well at St. Photini Church in Nablus, where Jesus shared "living water" with the Samaritan woman (John 4). Then on to Jericho, the oldest city in the world and first city, Israel's armies battled under Joshua's leadership after entering the land of Canaan. As the sun sets and the Jewish sabbath ends, we will begin our ascent to the majestic city of Jerusalem, where we will check into our hotel, enjoy dinner, and a good night's rest.

Day 7 – Sunday, January 12: Garden of Gethsemane, Bethlehem, Nativity Church, Shepherd's Field

We begin our celebration of the Lord's Day with a sweeping panoramic view of Jerusalem from the Mount of Olives. We then follow the Triumphal Entry path that took place on Palm Sunday and enter the Garden of Gethsemane with its ancient olive groves where Jesus prayed before his

betrayal by Judas. Following a time of reflection, we will travel to Bethlehem for our Sunday worship celebration at Shepherd's field, followed by a visit to the Church of the Nativity, the oldest church in the world, thought to be the place where Jesus was born. Then back to Jerusalem for dinner and overnight.

Day 8 – Monday, January 13: Qumran, Masada, Dead Sea Day 11 – Thursday, January 16: Arrive in USA

Following breakfast, we journey to the northern Judean desert to visit Qumran, home of the Dead-Sea-Scrolls. We will then ascend to Masada, the fortress built by King Herod with its ancient waterworks, synagogue, temples, and palaces. Our final stop will be a Spa on the Dead Sea, where we will enjoy lunch (included) and take advantage of relaxing in an indoor heated salt pool, freshwater pool, jacuzzi, and additional spa services like massages (not included). We then return to Jerusalem for dinner and overnight.



Day 9 – Tuesday, January 14: Western Wall, Temple Mount, Eastern Gate, Pools of Bethesda, St. Anne's Church, Church of the Holy Sepulcher

Our day of pilgrimage begins with a visit to the Western Wall of Herod's Temple, the holiest site in the entire Jewish world (if you have Jewish friends, invite them to give you written prayer requests to place in the wall), and the Temple Mount. We will then visit Bethesda's Pools, a place of healing (John 5), and St. Anne's Church, where you will hear the celestial sound of hymns sung by Christians from around the world. We will then stroll through the Old City of Jerusalem to The Church of the Holy Sepulcher, the most visited historical site in Israel. Following dinner, you may want to venture out again to behold the beauty of Jerusalem at night!

Day 10 – Wednesday, January 15: Emmaus, Kiryat Ye'arim, Caiphas' House, Shrine of the Book, Model City, Farewell Dinner Celebration, Ben Gurion Airport

Our day's activities will include a visit to Emmaus where the disciples' hearts burned within them as they walked with Jesus and recognized him in the breaking of bread, and Kiryat Ye'arim, where the Ark of the Covenant from the time of Samuel rested until David brought it to Jerusalem, celebrated in Psalm 24. We will then visit the House of

Caiaphas, where Jesus spent the night in a dungeon before his crucifixion, Shrine of the Book, where the Dead Sea Scrolls are displayed. If time permits, you might want to visit the Old City or visit another venue before we gather for our Farewell Dinner celebration! Then we transfer to Ben Gurion Airport for our flight home.

We arrive back in the United Sates after enjoying the pilgrimage of a lifetime and hopefully a greater understanding of our ancient Christian faith that will help make the Bible keep "coming alive" in the years to come!
