Day 7 - Sunday, January 26: Garden of Gethsemene, Bethlehem, Nativity, Chapel of the Holy Innocents, **Shepherd's Field**

Our day begins with a Panoramic view of the Mount of Olives followed by a time of reflection in the Garden of Gethsemene where Jesus prayed and sweat drops of blood before his betrayal by Judas.
