

Redland City Medical Centre – Patient Fee Summary (Effective 1 November 2025)

Redland City Medical Centre participates in the Australian Government's ****Triple Bulk Billing Incentive Program****.

This means that ****all eligible GP consultations**** are ****bulk billed**** for patients with a valid Medicare card.

Some procedures and specialised skin services are not included in this program and attract private fees.

Bulk Billed Services

The following services are fully bulk billed with no out-of-pocket cost:

- Standard GP consultations (Item 23, 36, 44)
- Telehealth consultations (standard and long)
- Health assessments and chronic disease care plans
- Mental health care plans and reviews

Private Fee Services (Non-Bulk Billed)

Some services are not covered under the Bulk Billing Incentive Program and attract private fees.

Typical private fees include:

- Cryotherapy (freezing of lesions): \$90 – \$150
- Shave or Punch Biopsy: \$120 – \$250 (depending on site and number of lesions)
- Skin Cancer Excision: \$250 – \$900 (based on size, complexity, and closure type)
- Cosmetic mole removal: \$200 per mole (non-Medicare)
- Employment / insurance medicals and forms: \$150 – \$250

Payment Information

- Patients will receive an estimate before any private procedure.
- Payment is required on the day of the procedure (EFTPOS / Credit Card accepted).
- Medicare rebates (where applicable) can be processed electronically at reception.
