Matthew 25 –8 March 2020 "Know You're Ready To See Jesus"

Introduction

- Christ has been in Jerusalem for the last week of His earthly ministry and life.
- In the midst of His agony of the pending cross, He takes time to answer disciple's questions re end times.
- They're on the Mt of Olives east of Jerusalem, so they call this the Olivet Discourse
- Matthew's 3 Great Discourses:
- Matt 5-7 The Idealic Nature of the Kingdom
- Matt 13 The Present Nature of the Kingdom
- Matt 24-25 The future entering into the Kingdom
- In Matt 24 He answered the disciple's questions about when His 2nd Coming would be.

Now in Matt 25 He continues to tell us 3 ways that we can know that we're ready for His coming.

He doesn't want us to be sign-watchers, He wants us to expect His imminent return.

#1 – We can know that we're ready when we've become born again (Chap 25:1-13)

Read Vs 1-5

- 1. 10 Bride's Maids $-\frac{1}{2}$ w/ oil & $\frac{1}{2}$ w/o oil
- 2. During a wedding betrothal or Ketubah the bride and her bride's maids would watch for the groom to come & call them away to the wedding.
- 3. Who are these bride's maids representing?
 - a. The church & all that lodge in its branches
 - b. Read Matt 13:31:32

Read Vs 6-9

- 1. The 5 w/o oil didn't have what was necessary
- 2. Oil is always a picture of the Holy Spirit
 - a. Read Zec 4:6
 - b. Water of the Word, Oil of the Spirit

- 3. Sometimes people miss the main point of Jesus' parables b/c they stumble on the fine details
 - a. Don't miss main points & press into rest.
 - b. Where to buy oil?
 - i. Probably express to get right with the Lord.

Read Vs 10-12

- 1. Read Matt 7:21-23
- 2. There are those that are around the church and within the church that are not of the church.
 - a. Read I John 2:19-20 They went out from us b/c they were not of us
 - b. Don't assume b/c someone is in a church building that they know the Lord to salvation
- 3. The only way to get the oil of the Spirit is to be born again...born from above.
 - a. Read Eph 1:13-14 earnest of the Spirit
 - b. Read Gal 3:1-3 begun in the Spirit

Read Vs 13

1. Be converted...TODAY is the day of salvation

#2 – We can know that we're ready b/c we're rightly using Christ's Spiritual Resources (Chap 25:14-30) Read Vs 14-15

- 1. God gives His precious resources to His created.
- 2. We're all giving different spiritual blessings and to different degrees.
 - a. But we all have gifts, the Word & the Spirit
 - b. It's up to us for how we use them.

Read Vs 16-23

- 1. Notice the Lord's answer is the same to both.
- 2. What did they both do that was the same?
 - a. They didn't return the same amt to Him.
 - b. But they both returned the same % to Him.
- 3. We're accountable, not for how many chances we have in life to serve Christ, but for how effective we use the chances that we're given.
 - a. Turn to Luke 19:16-19
 - b. B. Graham had many chances, maybe u have little, but use them effectively. (Rom 14:11-12)

Read Vs 24-25

- 1. This parable again has "the greater church" represented, those true believers and those who hang around it.
- 2. This man's own words show he has a great misunderstanding of who God is.
 - a. God's not putting us to work as a burden, but as a delight to be apart of His great plan!
 - b. His yoke is easy and burden is light.
 - c. Do you see God's service as God commanding you to do things? Or as a joy?
- 3. This sinner's response is, as in vs 25, "I was afraid and went and hid".
 - a. Just like Adam and Eve Gen 3
 - b. Like Moses at the burning bush Exo 3
 - c. Not understanding God causes us to run.

Read Vs 26-30

- 1. "Wicked" b/c he should have known God
- 2. "Slothful" This is his real problem

#3 – We can know that we're ready b/c we're rightly using Christ's Physical Resources (Chap 25:31-46) Read Vs 31-33

- 1. Notice this one isn't a parable; this is the conclusion to the Olivet Discourse of His coming.
- 2. At end of 7-year Tribulation, at Christ's 2nd Coming, all ethnic groups will be gathered b4 Him
- 3. This is not the Great White Throne Judgement.
 - a. This will happen at the end of Millennium as recorded in Rev 20
 - b. That judgement is only for unbelievers.
- 4. But what is the criteria to divide them?

Read Vs 34-40

- 1. The sheep on the right
 - a. This always the place of honor.
 - b. Benjamin son of my right hand
 - c. Jesus sits on the right hand of the Father
- 2. Vs 34 "prepared since the beginning"
 - a. This has always been the plan.

- 3. Vs 40 You helped "my brethren"
 - a. Most specifically this means Israelis
 - i. Read John 20:17
 - b. Can this be extrapolated to mean we should help all mankind, absolutely.
 - i. Read Gal 6:10
 - c. Our faith in Jesus will be expressed thru our care of Israel and all people who are special creations of God.
 - i. Read Jam 2:15-17
 - d. Are we using our money for the benefit of God's people or just ourselves?

Read Vs 41-46

- 1. Vs 41 "prepared for devil & his angels" a.It's never God desire for people to go to hell.
 - b. Read Eze 33:11
- 2. Their lack of help for God's people demonstrate their complete lack of faith/trust in Jesus Christ.

- 3. "Everlasting fire" (vs 41) & "Everlasting punishment (vs 46) & "Life eternal"
 - a. Our sin is against a perfect, infinite, everlasting God.
 - b. The punishment needs to meet the crime
 - c. We have an entire lifetime to make the choice, but when the day comes, our choice will stand forever
 - d. Think of it this way, if Christ rejecting rebels were not assured of eternal punishment, we would not be assured of eternal joy.
 - e. If someone is struggling with the concept of everlasting punishment, THERE'S A CURE!
 - i. Be converted today!
 - ii. Escape to everlasting life now
 - iii. God's riches are set before you, choose life!
- 4. So the proof of conversion is in how you treat people who are made in the image of God.

Conclusion

3 ways that you can know that you're ready for Jesus return (which can be at any moment)

1. Become born again

- a. Do you have the oil of the Holy Spirit convicting & guiding you?
- b. There are those around the church that are NOT headed to heaven. Maybe some you love.

2. Rightly be using the Spiritual resources God has given you

- a. Don't be concerned with the gifts and abilities that you don't have, just be effective using the ones you do have.
- b. It takes a right understanding of God to turn from vain efforts and pursue Godly efforts

3. Rightly be using the Physical resources God has given you

- a. Do good to all, but especially unto the...
