- 18. Dressage Suitability-judge concentrates on horse's purity of gaits, conformation and general impression.
- 19. Dressage Seat Equitation- judged on rider's performance, control of horse, use of riding aids, correct form, cleanliness and polish of horse, rider, and equipment.

Same horse/rider combination can enter a class only once.

A horse can be shown in a maximum of three classes.

You do not need to be a member of Oregon Dressage Society or Cascade Chapter in order to show but there is a \$25 fee per weekend for non-ODS-members.

If you would like to qualify for year-end awards you **do** need to be a member of the Cascade Chapter of the Oregon Dressage Society. **Third level & above rides are not eligible for ODS League Show awards.

LEVELS:

Intro through Fourth level Traditional Dressage.

Intro through Level 3 Western Dressage.

Beginner Novice through Intermediate Dressage.

AWARDS:

Ribbons 1st through 3rd place. High point awards will be given at each show for Training Level and above. One high point award for Open, AA and Junior rider per show. Must be present or have someone there to take your award home, awards will not be mailed.

Scores will count toward CCODS year end awards for CCODS members. A horse/rider combination must compete at a minimum of 3 shows to be eligible for year-end awards. League shows approved for year-end ODS state awards**.

ENTRIES:

\$40 per class for adults and \$30 for juniors. Please send a copy of ODS card with entry. Entries should be **POSTMARKED TWELVE DAYS** before closing date to Show Secretary. Closing Date is a week before the show. Please note: For League shows on entry sheet - \$1.00 per ride for ODS awards. Late entries or entries that are received after the closing date, a \$10.00 charge per entry will apply in addition to all other fees. Closing date will be 1 week prior to show date. **However, if mailed, entries must be postmarked 12 days prior to the show date**. Please enter by mail or hand to Maria in person.

RIDE TIMES:

Will be emailed (please make sure your email is legible and updated!). Classes may be scheduled out of order. Please send ride-time-requests at least one week prior to show. Ride-time requests will be considered but there is no guarantee that may be honored.

STABLING:

Please list how many stalls & nights for stabling. Stalls are \$40.00/ night/ stall. Please list if you want to be stabled with someone. Shavings not provided, please bring your own.

CONCESSIONS:

None available on grounds

VOLUNTEERS:

Always needed. Please let show secretary know when you can help and in what capacity.

REFUNDS:

No entries refunded aper closing date without a veterinarian's and/or doctor's cernficate. A service fee of \$7.50 will be deducted from all refunds.

OTHER:

Dogs are discouraged but must be on a leash if brought to the show. Boots & helmets with harness required for all riders. Gators & half chaps allowed. Turnout must be neat and tidy.

All horses brought to show grounds **must** be entered in the show. All CCODS shows in this series follow ODS League Show General Rules. Horses are not allowed to show in protective boots, warm up is fine but please remove before entering the arena. USEF/USDF RULE: At any time while mounted on the competition grounds, all riders **must** wear protective headgear. Protective headgear is defined as a riding helmet which meets or exceeds ATM/SEI standards for equestrian use & carries the SEI tag. It is suggested that a helmet be worn while lunging for safety.
