#### **Supporting Pet Owners, Strengthening Our Community**

At the Lakes Area Humane Society our mission goes far beyond caring for animals within our walls. We're dedicated to keeping pets and the people who love them together. Right now, our community is facing a growing need for affordable spay and neuter services, as well as support for pet owners who are struggling with behavioral challenges.

Every year, countless unwanted litters of puppies and kittens are born simply because affordable spay/neuter options are out of reach for many families. These unplanned litters often lead to overwhelmed owners, overcrowded shelters, and heartbreaking outcomes for animals that deserve loving homes.

To address this, we provide pet owners the names and contact information for lower cost spay/neuter services. By making these essential services accessible, we can help reduce pet overpopulation, prevent medical issues, and give every animal a better chance at a healthy, happy life. A list of organizations that provide these services is included on page 9 of this issue.

Behavioral challenges are another leading reason pets are surrendered to shelters. But many of these issues from excessive barking or destructive chewing to anxiety or aggression can often be successfully managed with the right support.

We believe that no one should have to give up their beloved companion due to behavior struggles. Our staff provides behavior counseling and referrals to trainers, obedience classes, and veterinary behavior specialists. Whether you need guidance on house training, socialization, or more complex behavioral concerns, we can help connect you with the right resources. One such resource that most pet owners are not aware of is a veterinary clinic that focuses completely on behavioral help, especially for pets with more difficult behavior concerns. By supporting pet owners before they reach a crisis point, we can keep more animals in loving homes and ease the strain on animal shelters. Together, we can create a stronger, more compassionate community where every pet has the chance to thrive.

Good afternoon LAHS!



## In the know... Distemper and Dogs

#### Is it Rabies... or Distemper? How to Protect your Pet.

The MN State Board of Animal Health recently posted the following article:

When a raccoon is seen stumbling through a yard or slumped on a roadside, the first fear is often rabies. Nationally, raccoons account for nearly a third of rabies cases. However, what a pet owner may not know is that a much more common threat to their dogs in MN is raccoon distemper, a virus that spreads quickly and can look very similar to rabies in its later stages.



Distemper is highly contagious, attacking the nervous,

respiratory, and digestive systems mostly infecting raccoons, dogs, skunks, and foxes. Early signs in raccoons resemble a cold or flu, with runny eyes and nose, coughing, or diarrhea, but as the disease progresses the animals may wander aimlessly, foam at the mouth, or suffer seizures. Unlike rabies, which often drives raccoons to become aggressive and bite, distemper usually leaves them weak and lethargic. Dogs are especially vulnerable if unvaccinated and can become infected from aerosols, feces, water or urine. More than half of dogs that contract distemper do not survive. Symptoms in dogs can progress from coughing and loss of appetite to bloody diarrhea, severe eye disease, seizures, and neurological damage.

The best protection for pets is prevention, especially vaccines. Keeping rabies and distemper vaccinations up to date is critical, and food, water, and trash should not be left outside because they can attract raccoons. If you spot a raccoon acting abnormally, do not approach it and keep your pets away while you call your local DNR conservation officer or local law enforcement. Contact your veterinarian immediately if your dog has been exposed to a suspected sick raccoon and they can advise you on booster shots and close monitoring of your pet. Unfortunately, distemper is common in raccoons and being proactive for your pet is the surest way to keep them safe.
