LENT: WALKING WITH JESUS

As we look to a new month, we look to the beginning of a new season in the church year, Lent. I used to think of Lent as little more than a joke as I gave it my all to give up things like homework, candy, and being nice to my brother. This was before I learned what Lent was, that it meant something, and that it had value and purpose. The season of Lent is when we turn our attention and focus on Jesus' journey toward the cross. The season calls us to reflect on the sober reality of the cost Jesus paid for setting us free from our sin. Fortunately, death is not the end of the story, thank God. Lent points past itself to Easter Sunday when we will celebrate the resurrection.

Lent begins on Ash Wednesday when we will gather to receive the imposition of ashes as a sign of our mortality. We will then spend forty days, not including Sundays, in repentance and preparation as a means of renewing our faith and encountering the reality of God. This period of renewal and encounter impacts our daily walk with Jesus. The idea of walking with Jesus is a metaphor used to describe our relationship with God and it is found throughout the Scriptures.

During Lent, you will have the opportunity to personally reflect and renew your walk with Christ through a sermon series, book study, and discussion group. Together we will study Adam Hamilton's book *The Walk, Five Essential Practices of the Christian Life*. In this book, Hamilton focuses on the New Testament foundation of worship, study, serving, giving, and sharing our faith. We will close out the study on Palm Sunday where we will see the five practices from the cross as we head into Holy Week. These essentials of the faith serve to not only deepen individual faith, but to strengthen us as a church. I hope that you will consider participating in the book study and discussion group.


