

### Examples of Intimacy with God NT

In the New Testament there are many examples of strong relationships with God, let's concentrate on three. First, in Philippians we see that Paul rejoiced in his suffering for Christ's sake; desired heaven more than anything, but was willing to remain on earth in order to be obedient; and he embraced and encouraged those

qualities that would focus Godly thoughts. In Ephesians and Romans Paul displayed his deep respect and adoration for the gospel found only in Christ. Second, Peter was willing to acknowledge his misdeeds and repent (Acts), he encouraged humility, submission to one another, and alertness; and a growing relationship with Christ. Third, John was a disciple who began as a self righteous hot-head, but ended up known as the disciple of love who reminds us that God is love. There are many more who are identified by their growing relationship with God. As you seek intimacy with God, realize that it isn't always a feeling, but a dedication and determination to seek God more fully every day (Luke 11: 8-10).
