

(Eph. 4:2) Part 5

On Dec 28th Pastor Terry outlined six ways we can *learn* and *live* Christ this year. The fifth was to **develop a new way of thinking**. Ephesians 4 says, to "be renewed in the spirit of your mind." Paul has similar wording in Philippians 2 where he outlines for us to be encouraged in Christ, find comfort in His love, have fellowship with the Spirit, be compassionate and loving and a list of what to put off. This is all done through prayer. We won't have palpable encouragement in Christ if we don't talk to Him. How can we have fellowship unless we have relationship? Prayer. When we pray we will have the mind of Christ. "Let this mind be in you which was also in Christ..." and then it goes on to tell us what the mind of Christ was. Philippians 2 is a great chapter to pray to develop a new way of thinking.
