Main Point: Although people are broken and sinful and often make their decisions based on their sinful and selfish desires, God is faithful and will accomplish His plan and purposes despite the actions of fallen humanity. God's desire is that broken and sinful people even today would turn to Him, turn from their sin, and put their faith in His Son, Jesus Christ, for salvation.

Broken people in Genesis 27:41 – 30:24

- Esau _____ Jacob and desired to murder his brother.
- Rebekah advised her son to avoid the conflict and to _____ to Haran.
- Rebekah _____ her husband, Isaac, to get him to send Jacob to her brother, Laban, in Haran.

Faithful God

- Isaac _____ Jacob again and asked that God's promise to Abraham and to himself would extend to his son, Jacob.

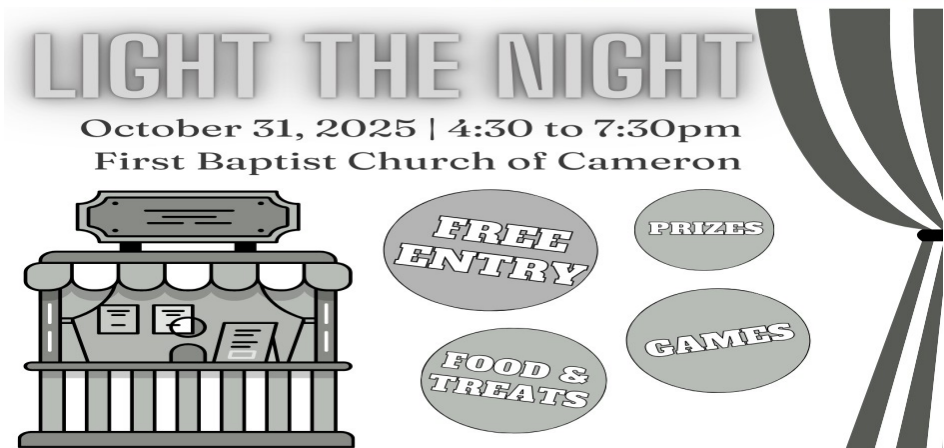

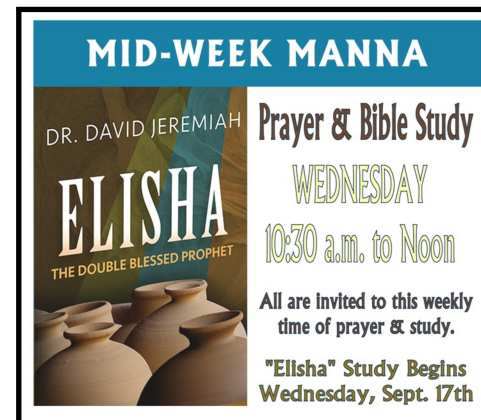
