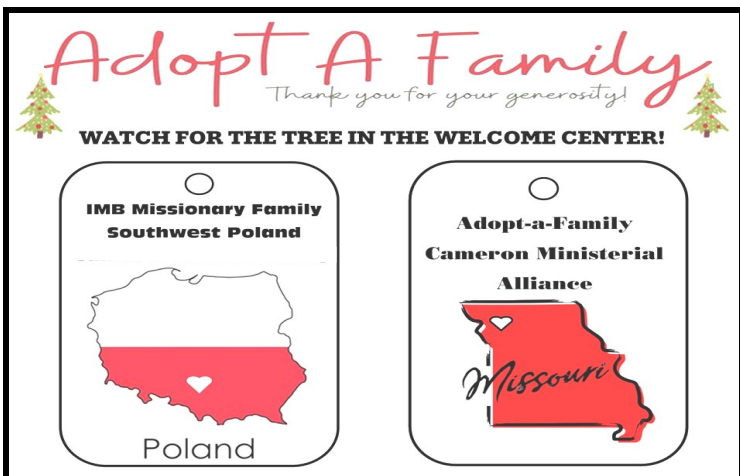
“In addition to all these things put on love, which is the perfect bond of unity.” Colossians 3:14
