**It was prayer and the Scriptures that united the Founding Fathers of the United States of America, and prayer can still unite us today.**

On September 5, 1774, the First Continental Congress met at Carpenters' Hall in Philadelphia. Among the delegates who attended were George Washington, Patrick Henry, Samuel Adams, John Adams, John Jay, and many others. This meeting was important since it was the first time the colonies united on a large scale. On September 7, Rev. Duché led the first prayer in Congress.

That time of prayer united the delegates despite their differences. In fact, Daniel Webster, "Defender of the Constitution," later reminded the US Supreme Court of the unifying power of prayer:

Mr. Duché read the Episcopal service of the Church of England and then, as if moved by the occasion, he broke out into extemporaneous prayer. And those men who were then about to resort to force to obtain their rights, were moved to tears; and floods of tears, Mr. Adams says, ran down the cheeks of the pacific Quakers who formed part of the most interesting assembly. Depend upon it, where there is a spirit of Christianity, there is a spirit which rises above form, above forms, independent of sect or creed, and the controversies of clashing doctrines.

# “I Am Free!”

Galatians 5:1

“In the freedom, then, with which Christ did make you free – stand ye, and be not held fast again by a yoke of servitude...” (YLT)

“In freedom, us Christ has set free, stand firm, therefore, and not again in a yoke of slavery entangle yourselves.” (Greek Text)

Main Point: Through His death and \_\_\_\_\_, Jesus Christ has set us free from the guilt-establishing and deadening \_\_\_\_\_ of the \_\_\_\_\_. Every heart serves either sin leading to \_\_\_\_\_ or God leading to \_\_\_\_\_.

I. I have a \_\_\_\_\_ of freedom.

- “*freedom*” – eleutheria – \_\_\_\_\_ – It is the God-given \_\_\_\_\_ from every form of \_\_\_\_\_ bondage so that the redeemed may \_\_\_\_\_ the Lord willingly, joyfully, and fruitfully.
- Paul insists that believers are no longer under the \_\_\_\_\_ power of the Mosaic \_\_\_\_\_.
- The theological significance of “freedom”:
  - Liberty flows from a once-for-all \_\_\_\_\_ in Christ; the \_\_\_\_\_ of the \_\_\_\_\_ no longer hangs over the believer. We have been \_\_\_\_\_ by faith. (Galatians 2:16)
  - Freedom is not moral indifference but \_\_\_\_\_ by the Holy Spirit. As the believer is being \_\_\_\_\_, we pursue \_\_\_\_\_ (1 Corinthians 6:11; 2 Corinthians 3:17)
  - Complete liberty awaits the \_\_\_\_\_ of creation, guaranteeing believers that our present \_\_\_\_\_ are temporary. (Romans 8:19-21)
  - Christian communities are to safeguard liberty by resisting both \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_. (1 Peter 2:16)

II. I have a \_\_\_\_\_ through Christ.

- Christ has \_\_\_\_\_ me *free*. – eleutherosen – to set free, released from \_\_\_\_\_; to remove \_\_\_\_\_ of sin because delivered by God into true spiritual \_\_\_\_\_. (John 8:36)
- “has set free” describes an act of decisive \_\_\_\_\_ – rescue from an \_\_\_\_\_ power into a state of unhindered \_\_\_\_\_ with God.

III. I have a \_\_\_\_\_ of confidence.

- “*stand firm*” – stekete – stand fast, \_\_\_\_\_, persevere; stand in God-given \_\_\_\_\_.
- Remain \_\_\_\_\_ in the truth, enabled by divine \_\_\_\_\_, until the day when faith becomes sight. (Ephesians 6:13-14)

IV. I have a previous \_\_\_\_\_ that has been forever revoked.

- “...and not again in a yoke of slavery entangle yourselves” – “yoke” – zygos – a \_\_\_\_\_; a wooden bar placed over the neck of a pair of animals so they can pull \_\_\_\_\_; what \_\_\_\_\_ (joins) two people to move (work) together as one.
- The yoke of \_\_\_\_\_ from which we are set free is the legalistic \_\_\_\_\_ of the law. (Acts 15:10-11)
- “*entangle yourselves*” – enecho – have a quarrel against; \_\_\_\_\_. In Matthew 11:29-30 – Jesus offers a yoke that is \_\_\_\_\_. Every person serves some master but Christ’s mastery \_\_\_\_\_ rather than \_\_\_\_\_.
