The Problem with \_\_\_\_\_

- In Roman Catholic doctrine, purgatory is the place where the souls of believers go to be \_\_\_\_\_ from sin until they are \_\_\_\_\_ to be admitted into heaven. (2 Maccabees 12:42-45)

Various Passages

## Defined
