PRAYING FOR OUR STUDENTS 2026-27

"And so, from the day we heard, we have not ceased to pray for you, asking that you may be filled with the knowledge of his will in all spiritual wisdom and understanding, so as to walk in a manner worthy of the Lord, fully pleasing to him: bearing fruit in every good work and increasing in the knowledge of God; being strengthened with all power, according to his glorious might, for all endurance and patience with joy; giving thanks to the Father, who has qualified you to share in the inheritance of the saints in light." Colossians 1:9-12 (ESV)

1. God to fill them with the knowledge of His will in all spiritual wisdom and understanding. Help them to discern right from wrong and make choices that align with God's principles.
2. God to guide our children to walk in a manner worthy of Him. Their actions, words, and attitudes to bring glory to His name. Empower them to be a positive influence in their schools, for those who are His to shine His light in a world that desperately needs it. Pray for them to stand firm for Biblical values and for them to clearly know what those values are.
3. Pray that our children will bear fruit in every good work. God to help them to use their talents and abilities for His purposes. May they be diligent in their studies, kind to their classmates, and compassionate towards those in need.
4. Ask God to strengthen our children with His power. Giving them the endurance and patience needed to navigate the challenges they may face at school. Fill them with joy and resilience, knowing that He is beside them every step of the way.
5. Finally, thank God for qualifying our children to share in the inheritance of the saints in light. Help them to understand the significance of their identity in Christ. May they find their worth and security in God alone, rather than seeking validation from their peers or worldly standards. Equip them to stand firm in their faith and live out their purpose with confidence.
