

FAMILY DINNER

How will you live worthily for Jesus Christ, your Savior and Lord, in 2026?
(Eph. 4:2) Part 2

On Dec 28th Pastor Terry outlined six ways we can *learn* and *live* Christ this year. The second was to **be taught** in Christ. Matthew 11: 28-30 is a great passage about learning and a big part is resting (Ps 46), along with following Christ's example (Philippians 2:5-8 & 1 Pet. 2:21-23), how we treat each other (Jn 13:14-15, Eph. 4:2 & Col. 3:12-13), and being in fellowship with His church (Heb. 10:24-25, Acts 2:42, 1 Thes. 5:11). How can we pray these passages? That would take awhile, but simply put it might go something like this: "Father You are the great Educator. No one teaches like You. Lord, humble me to learn from You. May I take time this week to rest in You. Not just rest from work, but to really lean into You and hear You so I can know You better, love You better and obey You out of love. May I learn to love as You love. I want to love those around me and my church better...more...deeper...unselfishly. Glorify Yourself in how I learn from You."


