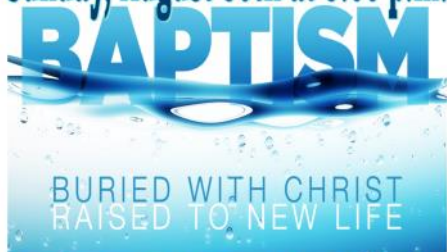

Praying for Malawi (Part 2)

The Malawi Team begins our second week ministering in Malawi. Here is a breakdown of how you can pray for the team daily as we begin God's mission trip. All prayer requests are completely dependent on and surrendered to God's will for any situation. Pray that we will look for God's hand in any "disruption" of our schedule, and that we will stay alert to any disruptions that are from the enemy.

- Aug 9: As you begin to worship we are 7 hours behind you. At Kairos Church our pastors will preach and our ladies will teach Sunday School for the children-- all ages. Lunch and fellowship will follow with training afterwards. **Pray for meaningful fellowship and that what the congregation needs to hear will be taught and hearts and minds will be open to receive.** In the evening will be a Sports Outreach (soccer) with the Gospel presented at halftime. **Pray for the teams to be receptive to the Gospel and the enemy to be powerless.**

- Aug 10: Day begins with a 2 hr. drive to and from a neighboring village. We will secure approval from local chiefs for us to be in their village. **Pray they give their ok.** Pastor and Leader Training: **Pray for discernment for what they most need to hear. Every year there have been a few who receive Christ themselves for the first time, so pray for salvation and willingness to receive the true Gospel. Ask for pastors/leaders to be equipped with much they can implement and share with their churches.** Children's Activities: We will have groups of 100+ kids. We plan on sharing about the God who Created, Noah and the ark that saves, the 10 Commandments and God's desire for us to be in relationship with Him, and finally Salvation using color bracelets. **Pray for the kids to be well behaved and to be able to listen.** In the evening there will be a Sports Outreach (soccer). The Gospel is always shared with the team and adults. Kids from the day are everywhere. **Pray for someone who speaks Chichewa to help minister to the children and keep them calm. Pray for the teams to be receptive to the Gospel and the enemy to be powerless.**

- Aug 11: Leave Mangochi for Lilongwe and YouthCare Ministries. **Pray for our time with the children and staff there. Pray for meaningful conversations and times of encouragement and their growth to be firm in the Lord Jesus.**

- Aug 12: Spend the day with IMB missionaries in Lilongwe. **Pray that we will be able to learn how to better minister to the people of Malawi and to be a help to our missionaries.**

- Aug 13: We say "So long" to Malawi and prepare for the long trip home. **Pray for a quiet journey (many Africans travel with many children and the plane can often be very loud).**

- Aug 14: Arrive back home to KC. Continue to pray for Malawi. Even if someone didn't accept Christ a seed was planted. **Pray that the seeds won't be snatched by the enemy, but they will flourish and grow. Pray for those who did receive, to grow into mature believers who will share Jesus boldly.**

- Aug 15: This will be our first full day back in the US. Please **pray for our transition, relief from jet lag, and that we adjust to being back home while continuing to pray for God's work in Malawi.**

Thank you for your prayers and support. We can definitely tell when you are praying. In this way you are a VITAL part of this mission journey.
