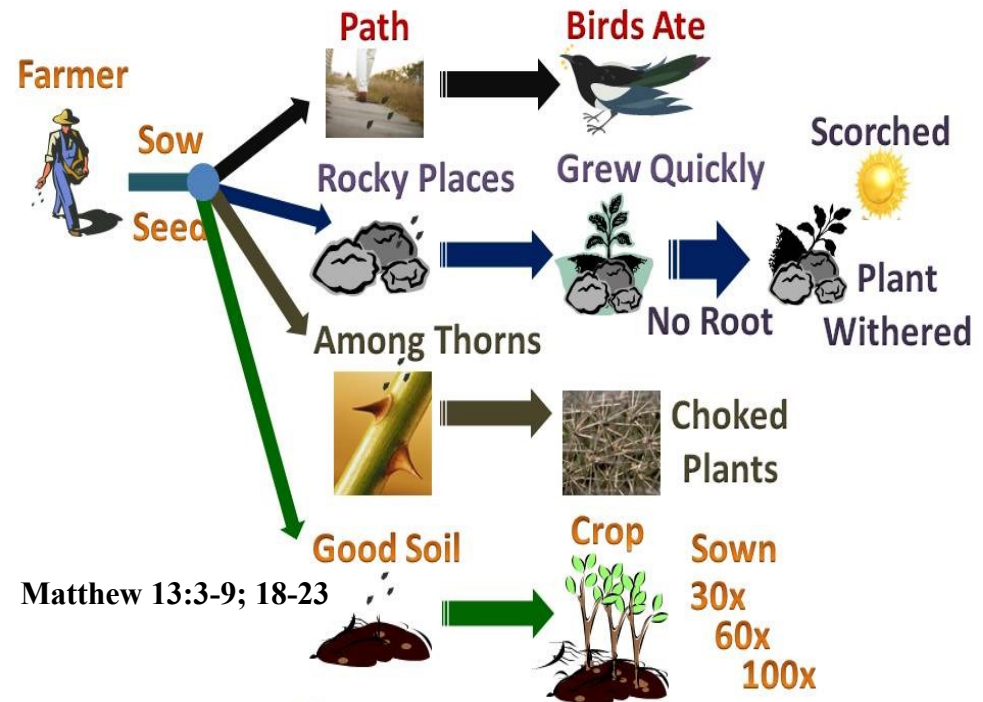
One-Shot Women's Ensemble

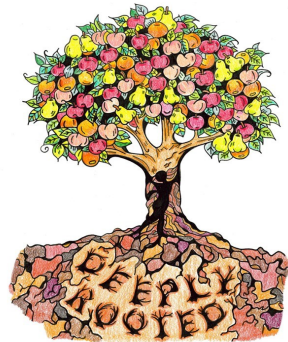
