


FEBRUARY SHOEBOX ITEMS

Women in Prayer

Women were created to be helpers "suitable" or "comparable" to men. In the Hebrew that word means "conspicuous, before the eyes of, parallel to." Women are important! (Men are important too, by the way.) Throughout the Bible the prayers of women were pivotal. It is obvious many of the women in the Bible prayed, but whose prayers are not recorded: Eve, Sarah, Rachel, Esther, Ruth, Anna, Mary Magdalene and many others. Some whose prayers are recorded are: Hannah, Hagar, Miriam, Deborah, Elizabeth, and Mary (Jesus' mother). In her book "Lord, Change Me" Evelyn Christensen said that the best prayer we can pray for ourselves—not others—is, "Lord, change ME." In the Bible there are many prayers we can use as examples to pray, which is probably what the upcoming study for women is all about. The prayer team encourages all the women of FBCC to attend. It is only for 7 weeks, but it will be well worth your time and effort.
